

**THE 'OTHER' SAINT.** This week, on February 3, we have the option of honoring 'the other Saint' who lives in the shadow of Saint Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, whose intercession for those who suffer from diseases of the throat or any other illness makes him far more popular. And it seems that one of the liturgical innovations for which he is known may soon become a thing of the past ... which would seem apropos for this 'other' Bishop. For many of the churches and holy sites he founded or supported were eventually suppressed or destroyed! Such was the life and ministry of Saint Ansgar, aka Anskar, Anschar or Oscar. After praying the Collect for his Feast Day Mass, we will explain his short-lived - but crucial - contributions to the Church in Scandinavia, in the Northern Countries, and elsewhere.

**Collect - Saint Ansgar, Bishop**

O God, who willed to send the Bishop Saint Ansgar to enlighten many peoples, grant us, through his intercession, that we may always walk in the light of your truth. Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

**THE 'APOSTLE OF THE NORTH.'** Born into French nobility on September 8, 801, the future Saint Ansgar, whose name blends two Germanic words: 'ans' [God] and 'ger' [spear] became a Benedictine monk. In 826, he accompanied the exiled King Harold when he returned to Denmark and began to plant the seeds of Christianity in that then-pagan land. He founded Sweden's in 829, but Viking pagans forced the Church into hiding and eventually, and quite forcefully, into extinction. In 831, Pope Gregory IV ordained him to the episcopacy, appointed him the first Archbishop of Hamburg, Germany, and the Papal legate to the Scandinavian countries. After laboring in the ministry for 13 years, almost everything he had established was literally burned to the ground. Sweden remained a pagan country until missionaries returned some two centuries later.

**COMPOSER OF THE PSALM-PRAYER.** The Church makes very liberal use of the Old Testament's Book of Psalms: 150 biblical, poetic hymns. We sing or recite one at every Mass; many hymns we sing paraphrase a Psalm. They are also used during the Divine Office or Liturgy of the Hours, of which Morning, Evening and Night Prayer are the most common. Hymns found in other Old Testament books or in the New Testament are called Canticles, rather than Psalms. Jesus often used these biblical Psalms and Canticles in His personal and communal prayer. As did His Mother and the Prophets.

Since Jesus is the fulfillment of all Scripture, we must always be open to how each Psalm or prophesy points - either directly or indirectly - to Jesus. Sometimes, it is obvious: "You are my son; today I have begotten you." [Psalm 2:7] - "May the kings of Tarshish and the islands bring tribute, the kings of Sheba and Seba offer gifts. May all kings bow before him," [72:10-11] - "You will not abandon me to death, nor will you suffer your holy one to see corruption." [16:10, in the Greek translation] - and the paraphrased, "The Queen stands at your right hand arrayed in gold." [45:10] refers to His Mother.

**TRUST IN GOD'S PLAN.** Some might say that Saint Ansgar was an absolute failure: the Scandinavian missions he painstakingly planted were uprooted and destroyed; the Psalm-Prayers he composed may soon be ditched; one wonders what the future of our Christian Faith will be in Germany. Yet that was not his concern, nor ours; for it seemed that Jesus' earthly mission was also a failure! So, trust that God has a plan, just as Saint Ansgar did, and that we are part of God's plan ... and that, in the end, it will all be worth it!

Even Saint Ansgar's hopes and prayers to die as a martyr for the cause did not materialize; he died of natural causes on February 3, 865. In art, he is often depicted as a miter-topped Bishop, holding a church that recalls how he helped to build up Christ's Body, His holy Church, in Scandinavia and Germany. As this Patron Saint of Scandinavia, Denmark, and Sweden reminds us: God calls us to be faithful, not successful! Saint Ansgar, pray for us!


