From the Pastor
5th Sunday in
Ordinary Time - B
February 7, 2021

'FORTUNATE ONE.' 74 years ago tomorrow, in 1947, a very gentle, charismatic native of Sudan's Darfur region, entered into her eternal rest. Born around 1869, she was cared for by Sisters in an Italian convent. On January 9, 1890, as an adult, she was baptized by

Giuseppe Cardinal Sarto [later, Pope Pius X] who also confirmed her and gave her First Holy Communion the same day - decades before the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or RCIA was promulgated!

Due to the traumas she had endured as a child, she could not recall the name her parents had given her! So she took the Christian name Josephine in honor of Saint Joseph, who protected the Holy Family from those with evil intent, and kept the name Fortunata [or Bakhita in her native tongue], which had been given to her along the way - which is a story in itself! After praying the Collect for her Feast Day, which is tomorrow, February 8, we will highlight the amazing saga of Saint Josephine Bakhita.

Collect - St. Josephine Bakhita, Virgin

O God, who led Saint Josephine Bakhita from abject slavery to the dignity of being your daughter and a bride of Christ, grant, we pray, that by her example we may show constant love for the Lord Jesus crucified, remaining steadfast in charity and prompt to show compassion. Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

A MOST UNFORTUNATE START. Born into a prosperous African family, she lived a somewhat privileged life, since her uncle was the local tribal chief. However, as a young child, she was abducted by Arab slave traders and forced to walk 600 miles to a slave market. For the next 12 years, she was sold to a variety of 'owners.' Most of her cruel captors mistreated her horribly. She was so severely beaten after she broke a vase, she was incapacitated for over a month. She was permanently wounded; some reports say she had a total of 114 scars; as soon as her wounds healed, they inflicted even more pain on her. Mercifully, in 1883, she was 'bought' by an Italian Vice Consul to Sudan who treated her kindly.

FREE AT LAST! When the Consul's term was up, Josephine begged him to let her go with him to Italy, and he agreed. Eventually, she was given to another family as their nanny; but when her new mistress had to travel to Sudan, she placed Josephine in the care of the Canossian Sisters in Italy, who taught her about God and prepared her to become a Catholic. When her mistress returned and tried to 'reclaim' her, she refused to leave. The Sisters interceded on her behalf with Italian authorities who ruled that, since slavery had been outlawed in Sudan before she was even born, Josephine was a free woman!

SERVANT SISTER. While she said she always knew there was a God who created all things, she did not know Him personally; she was most grateful to the Sisters who shared their faith in Jesus with her. With their help, she became Catholic, as mentioned above, and discerned God's call to the Religious Life. On December 7, 1893, she became a novice, and on December 8, 1896, she made final vows with the Canossian Daughters of Charity and was assigned to another convent in Italy where, for 40 years, she served as the convent's cook and doorkeeper.

THE MAKINGS OF A SAINT. Known for her gentle voice and positive attitude - a minor miracle, given all the pain inflicted on her - she visited other convents to 'share her story' with Sisters preparing to be sent to African missions. No menial task was beneath her. Eventually confined to a wheelchair, no doubt from the long-term, residual effects of the abuse she so bravely endured, her spirit never dimmed. She even spoke lovingly about her kidnappers, through whom, as she saw it, God set her on her life's course. Whenever anyone asked her how she was, she would reply, "As the Master desires."

Based on her forgiving nature, her devotion to Religious Life and to our Blessed Mother, Pope Saint John Paul II declared her Venerable in 1978, but her beatification was censored in Sudan. Nine months later, while visiting Sudan, he publicly honored her, and on October 1, 2000, canonized her as the Patron Saint of the Sudan and of all who suffer because of human trafficking. Saint Josephine Bakhita, pray for us.


