Last Sunday Before Lent!

**NEWEST DOCTOR OF  
THE CHURCH.** On  
February 2, 2021,  
Pope Francis added

Saint Gregory of Narek, Abbot and Doctor of the Church as an optional memorial on February 27, his Feast Day. On April 12, 2015, Pope Francis had bestowed on him an honorary title, making him the 36<sup>th</sup> 'Doctor of the Church,' among which there are four females. As previously noted, the 'Doctors' are not 'MDs' or medical doctors, but more like 'PhD' doctors, whose theological insights, which they gained and/or shared through their research, writings or study - and their holiness of life - so helped the Church that a Pope declared them to be a 'Doctor of the Church.' After praying the temporary Collect for the Mass in his honor [the English translation of the Latin text is awaiting Vatican approval] we will explain his 'story' and his ecumenical and political significance.

**Saint Gregory of Narek, Doctor/Abbot - Collect**

Lord God, who graciously imbued blessed Gregory of Narek with heavenly doctrine, grant, through his intercession that we may keep that same teaching faithfully and express it in what we do. Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

**GREGORY OF NAREK.** Born around 945, he was the son of an archbishop in the Armenian Apostolic Church, an Eastern Rite Church that still permits Priests and once allowed Bishops to be married. After his parents died, he and his older brother were raised by an uncle who had them educated at the monastery in Narek, in what is now eastern Turkey; it was demolished in 1915. He began as a Monk and was ordained a Priest at 25; he spent most of life at the monastery, teaching and writing poetry. He is considered Armenia's greatest poet and mystic; his prayer book, commonly called his 'Book of Lamentations,' has been translated into 30 languages. It was his hope that all people, in all places, dealing with any situation, would find comfort and hope in his poetic reflections on the sacred Scriptures. He died in 1003.

**ECUMENICAL IMPORTANCE.** In 451, at the Council of Chalcedon, the Church defined Jesus Christ's dual nature: True God and True Man. By rejecting this dogma, the Armenian Apostolic Church severed communion with the Roman [Latin] Catholic Church and other Eastern Rite Churches. But in 1996, Pope Saint John Paul II and his Armenian episcopal [bishop] counterpart, Apostolic Catholicos Karekin I, formally ended the schism, which restored full communion between the two Churches. While the Latin or Roman Catholic Church and Armenian Catholic Church have different liturgical forms and disciplines, we **CAN** receive holy communion in each other's churches. However, when I have concelebrated Byzantine or other Eastern Rite Masses, I get totally lost!

**POLITICAL IMPORTANCE.** During WWI, the battles in Europe were the main focus, but terrible crimes against humanity were also committed by the Ottoman Empire in present-day Turkey; this tragedy sadly flew under most 'radar screens.' The once-thriving Christian community in Narek was annihilated; its famed Monastery was destroyed; its Cathedral became a Mosque; some 600,000 to 1.5 million Christians were deported into the desert or murdered by their conquerors. Narek is presently a Moslem Kurdish community, with few, if any, Christians.

Sadly, few world leaders, with notable exception, call what Turkey did a 'genocide.' President Reagan did so in an unofficial statement; but the first US President to use the word 'genocide' was President Biden. And while Pope John Paul II referred to it - in passing - as a 'genocide,' Pope Francis was the first to do so officially, which infuriated the Turkish government. He did so on April 12, 2015, at a Mass in the Armenian Catholic Rite held in Saint Peter Basilica, over which he 'presided.' The truth was finally told! [When Mass is celebrated in a Rite other than the Latin or Roman [with which we are most familiar] that is in union with the Catholic Church - or if a Priest presides - the Bishop or Pope [the Bishop of Rome] is not the main celebrant; he sits in a place of honor and 'presides' over the Mass and may also give the homily.] Now you know! Saint Gregory of Narek, pray for us!



## Lenten Observances & Worship At Our Parish



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

During the days and weeks of penance that lie ahead --- from **Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022 until Holy Thursday, April 14, 2022** --- the Catholic Church throughout the world commemorates the penitential season of Lent ending with the Sacred Triduum of Holy Week. The model Jesus gave us for “these forty days” was his own experience in the desert and the temptations that followed him there where he encountered Satan face to face. And yet, Jesus, there in the desert --- alone, fasting and in intense prayer --- beat back the devil and triumphed over temptation, as strong and as

unrelenting as it was throughout those forty days.

We enter the desert of Lent like Jesus, led by the Holy Spirit, to face our devils, our temptations head on. But we are not alone. The Lord Jesus Christ is with us. And so, too, is the Church, the entire community of faith observing Lent. Here is what the Catholic Church in the United States requires of us as baptized Catholics:

**The days of FAST (only one full meal) and ABSTINENCE (no meat) are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** No dispensations are granted on these solemn days except for reason of sickness or those provided in canon law below. The pastor of a parish has the authority to give a dispensation to individual parishioners in his parish. The Bishop alone has the authority to dispense groups of Catholics but only for a serious reason.

Those who are automatically dispensed from fast and abstinence regulations outside the age limits noted below include: the physically or mentally ill, especially individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also included in the dispensation are women who are pregnant or nursing. In all cases, common sense should prevail and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops).

Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to FAST (only one full meal) as above. From the age of 14, people are also obliged to ABSTAIN (no meat: this obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products or condiments of any kind, even though made from animal fat).

The obligation to observe the laws of fast and abstinence is a serious one for Catholics. Failure to observe one penitential day in itself is not considered a serious sin. It is the intentional failure to observe any penitential days at all, or a substantial number of penitential days, that must be considered a serious matter.

The obligation, the privilege really, of receiving the Eucharist at least once a year --- often called “Easter duty” --- for those in the state of grace should still be fulfilled during the period from the **First Sunday of Lent, March 5-6, 2022 to Trinity Sunday, June 12, 2022.** However, the Church’s law does permit this precept to be fulfilled at another time during the year when there is a just cause.

I want to encourage all Catholics, especially those conscious of serious sin, to go to confession and to make use of the sacrifices and traditions that have always been part of our Lenten practices in the Church. We do, indeed, fast and pray with the Lord Jesus and with our fellow Catholics. May this Lent be a time of penance leading to grace and joy for us all at Easter.
