*Reflections on Today's Readings by Rev. Leonard N. Peterson*

## **Reading I: Isaiah 50: 4-7**

Like the prophets before him, Isaiah is mistreated and ignored, to the point of having spittle on his face. But his face is strong like flint. A direct reference to Christ's treatment.

## **Reading II: Philippians 2: 6-11**

St. Paul exhorts his readers to selflessness. He quotes from an extant and beautiful hymn of the early Church. It poignantly describes both the abasement and the exaltation of Christ Jesus our Lord.

## **The Gospel: Mark 14: 1-15:47 or 15: 1-39**

The Gospel of Mark has been described by scholars as "A Passion Narrative with a long introduction." Be that as it may, this latter part is key to the rest of the gospel.

From the Pastor  
Palm Sunday  
of the Lord - B  
March 28, 2021

**YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH.** In this end of our four-part series on the Holy Father's Apostolic Letter, 'Patris corde' ['With a Father's Heart'], which you are encouraged to read, we reflect on the final two parts of this Letter's seven sections. [Go to [www.vatican.va](http://www.vatican.va) - select Apostolic Letters - and choose 'Patris corde.'] To read the previous three articles, download the bulletins from 03/7, 03/14 and 03/21. We begin by praying the oration chosen by Pope Francis, which he himself prays each day.

**Year of Saint Joseph - Official Prayer**

Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,  
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.  
To you God entrusted his only Son;  
in you Mary placed her trust;  
with you Christ became man.  
Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself  
a father and guide us in the path of life.  
Obtain for us grace, mercy, and courage,  
and defend us from every evil. Amen.

**A WORKING FATHER.** As the highly symbolic biblical account of creation makes clear: God did NOT give us a finished product so that we could just 'kick back' and enjoy ourselves! According to the second story of Creation, "The LORD God then took the man and settled him in the garden of Eden, to cultivate and care for it." [Genesis 2:15]. Then by bringing sin into the world by our pride and disobedience, God said, "Cursed is the ground because of you! In toil you shall eat its yield all the days of your life. Thorns and thistles it shall bear for you, and you shall eat the grass of the field. By the sweat of your brow you shall eat bread, until you return to the ground, from which you were taken; for you are dust, and to dust you shall return. [ibid 3:17b-19]. And as the effects of sin grew in human hearts, many took advantage of this 'curse' and enslaved those who had to work for a living, further destroying our God-given human dignity which sin did not obliterate! So the Church came to the rescue.

In his 1891 encyclical, 'Rerum Novarum' ['Of New Things'] Pope Leo XIII offered the Church's biblical insights into how the human need to work and for one's living, and the right to own and run workplaces can be done in such a way as us, we can also always accept God's will! to respect our God-given human dignity and the rights of all. For as world history has shown, either extreme: the enslavement of workers - or a welfare state, where all is provided, even for those who do not do for themselves what they can do - is a dismal failure. We can also turn to the carpenter, and to the carpenter's Son, for they role-modeled doing the work God entrusts to us while making time for family and friends, recreation and, above all, worship and prayer.

**A FATHER IN THE SHADOWS.** When I first saw this subtitle, I thought of the many fathers who watch and pray - from sidelines or bleachers, audiences or stands, pews or benches, rooting for their children as they live out their calling. I know how proud my father was when he saw me celebrate my First Mass, held his grandchildren, and saw his children's successes. I also know that his heart ached when he watched us ill or defeated. And I am sure that, for as long as Saint Joseph lived, he shared in Jesus' joys and sorrows.

But Pope Francis gave a different twist to this image of a father in the shadows. He suggested, based on a novel by Jan Dobraczyński, in his book, *The Shadow of the Father*, the Holy Father encourages us to see all fathers as a 'shadow' of our Heavenly Father. For in each father, whether he be a father by helping conceive, adopting, fostering - or like me, through Ordination, all fathers can and should be the means by which God the Father is present to us, albeit in a 'shadowy' way. What a powerful way to see the hope and comfort every 'father' can bring to his 'children.' What a different way for me to see what I have been called to do as your priestly 'Father!' Through the intercession of Saint Joseph, may all the intentions we have entrusted to him at his shrine find favor with our Heavenly Father. And may Saint Joseph help all fathers to be the comforting shadow of God our Father and of His Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ. Saint Joseph, pray for us!


