From the Pastor

Just as it would not be Happy Easter, Alleluia, Alleluia. Even on this most joyful of days, we must take time to learn more about our great Catholic Faith. For your Easter reflection, we'll reflect on two parts of the annual **Renewal of Baptismal Promises**, which is required only at the Easter **VIGIL** Mass, and is an option, in lieu of the Creed, at Easter **DAY** Masses. Why? The Easter **VIGIL** Mass, the Mother of all Vigils, is the most important and climatic Mass of the liturgical year; but since far more people attend the Easter **DAY** Mass [and some sadly avoid the **VIGIL** Mass at all costs!], this key component of Easter may be repeated. So let's look at the introduction and conclusion of the annual **Renewal of Baptismal Promises**.

**Renewal of Baptismal Promises - Introduction**

Dear brothers and sisters, through the Paschal mystery we have been buried with Christ in Baptism, so that we may walk with him in newness of life. and so, now that our Lenten observance is concluded, let us renew the promises of holy Baptism, by which we once renounced Satan and his works and promised to serve God in the holy Catholic Church. and so I ask you:

**BURIED WITH CHRIST THROUGH BAPTISM.** This profoundly theological, biblically-based line, is based on two quotes from Saint Paul found in Romans 6:3-5; Colossians 2:12; it is also based on what Jesus said to Nicodemus: "No one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above." Nicodemus said to him, 'How can a person once grown old be born again? Surely he cannot reenter his mother's womb and be born again, can he?' To which Jesus said: 'No one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit.'" [c.f. John 3:3-5] However, being 'born again' in Baptism is just the first step!

For while we are graced "with every spiritual blessing in the heavens" [Ephesians 1:3] by God when He made us His own in Baptism, we also inherit the fallout of our first parents, Adam and Eve's 'Original Sin.' So each year we are offered the opportunity to reject Satan and all his empty promises and evil with three "I do's" - and then

we renew our commitment to our triune God with three "I do's" to our belief in the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Yet there's still more, for we also recommit ourselves to God's holy Church, to her Sacraments and teachings, her communal activities in which we gain the strength to reject evil and live for God - to 'die to self' and to 'live for Christ.' Keep this in mind each year in the annual **Renewal of Baptismal Promises**.

**Brief Address - Renewal of Baptismal Promises**

And may almighty God,  
the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,  
who has given us new birth  
by water and the Holy Spirit  
and bestowed on us forgiveness of our sins, keep  
us by his grace, in Christ Jesus our Lord,  
for eternal life. Amen.

**MAY GOD KEEP US BY HIS GRACE.** We cannot fulfill the promises we make at Baptism without God's grace. However, as with all things, we must start with what God has done for, and continues to offer to us. As the conclusion of this annual Easter Rite notes, God gives us 'new birth by water and the Holy Spirit' [Baptism and [Confirmation]; the 'forgiveness of our sins' [Penance] and a pledge to 'keep us by his grace in Christ Jesus our Lord' [Eucharist, Anointing of the Sick, Matrimony & Holy Orders]. And God fulfills all these promises to us through His Church ... especially, as just noted, through the Sacraments; but are we keeping our end of this unbelievable bargain?

We cannot be passive, and certainly not inactive, if our new life in Christ is going to take root, develop and grow, benefit us - and save us. So many analogies come to mind: a health club membership does us no good unless we work out at the gym; a driver's license is useless unless we learn to drive ... and get in the car and go; a winning lottery ticket does us no good until we redeem it, and suffer the consequences [loss of privacy, taxes, etc.] needed to claim our prize. So, too, with our Baptism and our new life in Christ!

What will you do this Eastertime to better know, understand and enjoy your new life in Christ? If you have not already done so, sign up for Formed. It is free, easy to sign up and offers a great wealth of information about our Catholic Faith. A Blessed Easter to all!

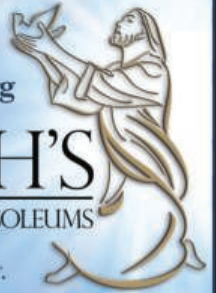
