



From the Pastor

**CHRISM MASS:  
RENEWAL OF**

**PRIESTLY PROMISES.** In 1970, Pope Saint Paul VI added a Renewal of Priestly Promises to the Chrism Mass. While the rubrics stress that this Mass manifest the communion of all Priests with their Bishop, who should strive to concelebrate with him, all the faithful are encouraged to participate in it. The rubrics also direct the Bishop to address his homily to his Priests [it's one of the rare times, in layman's lingo, that the 'General gets to address his Troops'] - but all are encouraged to listen and heed his message, especially about praying for all Priests, past, present and future. Then, after his homily, the Bishop stands at his cathedra or chair, dons the miter, and holds the crozier - symbols of his office as chief shepherd, teacher and leader, to address all Priests, who also stand.

**Renewal of Priestly Promises - Question #1**

Beloved sons, on the anniversary of that day when Christ our Lord conferred his priesthood on his Apostles and on us, are you resolved to renew, in the presence of your Bishop and God's holy people, the promises you once made? I am.

**"ON HIS APOSTLES AND ON US."** When Jesus said, "... do this in memory of me." [Luke 22:19] He meant far more than sharing the bread and wine that He changed into His Sacred Body and Precious Blood. He also meant the Ordination of the first Priests, the Apostles; how do we know Jesus 'ordained' them? By washing their feet! Exodus chapter 40 describes in detail how Moses ordained his brother Aaron and the first Priests: they were first washed, even their feet, clothed in sacred garments, and anointed with oil. So, through their successors, our Bishops, Sacred or Holy Orders are handed on to us!

**Renewal of Priestly Promises - Question #2**

Are you resolved to be more united with the Lord Jesus and more closely conformed to him, denying yourselves and confirming these promises about sacred duties towards Christ's Church which, prompted by love of him, you willingly and joyfully pledged on the day of your priestly ordination? I am.

**SACRED DUTIES.** An old Navy commercial said, "It's not just a job ... it's an adventure." But God's call to Holy Orders is even more awesome; for those who accept that call literally continue Christ's ministry in unique ways: we bless and consecrate, baptize and confirm, witness promises and vows, forgive sins and anoint the sick, and Bishops ordain. For by being united to Christ, we do what He did!

**Renewal of Priestly Promises - Question #3**

Are you resolved to be faithful stewards of the mysteries of God in the Holy Eucharist and the other liturgical rites and to discharge faithfully the sacred office of teaching, following Christ the Head and Shepherd, not seeking any gain, but moved only by zeal for souls? I am.

**STEWARDS OF DIVINE MYSTERIES.** As I explained above, we are stewards entrusted with sacred duties for which we must give an account! So, pray for us as we pray for you!

**The People's Promises to Pray for their Priests**

As for you, dearest sons and daughters, pray for your Priests, that the Lord may pour out his gifts abundantly upon them, and keep them faithful as ministers of Christ, the High Priest, so that they may lead you to him who is the source of salvation.

People: Christ, hear us. Christ, graciously hear us.

And pray also for me, that I may be faithful to the apostolic office entrusted to me in my lowliness and that in your midst I may be made day by day a living and more perfect image of Christ, the Priest, the Good Shepherd, the Teacher and the Servant of all.

People: Christ, hear us. Christ, graciously hear us.

May the Lord keep us all in his charity and lead all of us, shepherds and flock, to eternal life. Amen.

### FAST AND ABSTINENCE GUIDELINES

**"The days of FAST (only one full meal) and ABSTINENCE (no meat) are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** No dispensations are granted on these solemn days except for reason of sickness or those provided in canon law below. The pastor of a parish has the authority to give a dispensation to individual parishioners in his parish.

The Bishop alone has the authority to dispense groups of Catholics but only for a serious reason.

Those who are automatically dispensed from fast and abstinence regulations outside the age limits noted below include: the physically or mentally ill, especially individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also included in the dispensation are women who are pregnant or nursing. In all cases, common sense should prevail and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops).

Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to FAST (only one full meal) as above. From the age of 14, people are also obliged to ABSTAIN (no meat: this obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products or condiments of any kind, even though made from animal fat. 


