From the Pastor
Ascension of the Lord - B

Mother's Day

A MOTHER'S JOY & A TRUE TEENAGE ROLE MODEL. By coincidence or Divine Providence, one of the three Saints we honor on May 12 is apropos for Mother's Day. A London railroad station is named

after him, although Saint Pancras [probably] never set foot in England! And he is a Patron Saint of Teenagers. Why? Read on ... but first ... to know why we do not use the Mass orations that honor Saint Pancras or the other two martyrs we honor on May 12: Saints Nereus and Achilleus, consult last week's bulletin which highlighted the life and death of these two martyrs, who are also from antiquity. Let's begin by praying the Collect from the holy Mass offered in honor of Saint Pancras.

Saint Pancras, Martyr

May your Church rejoice, O God,
confident in the intercession of
the Martyr Saint Pancras,
and by his glorious prayers
may she persevere in devotion to you
and stand ever firm.
Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever.
Amen.

LEGENDS & PIOUS TRADITIONS. We must **ONLY** believe what is in **Sacred Scripture** and **Tradition**: the Church's **official** decrees by which she applies Divine Revelation to whatever issues she faces in every age. **Personal** revelations, even **Marian apparitions** are optional; the Church merely 'approves' them if they are consistent with the **Deposit of Faith**. She also permits, and sometimes encourages, all that helps us to understand and live out our **Faith**: the **Rosary**, **Stations of the Cross**, and other devotions; the use of **relics**, like the **Shroud of Turin**, icons and sacred images, and even legends ... which **finally** brings us back to **Saint Pancras**.

We have no verifiable historical records of Saint Pancras' life, deeds or death, but we have reliable sources from soon after his lifetime who testify to his existence and execution. Born at the end of the 3rd Century in current-day Turkey, his mother reportedly died in childbirth, making today the

perfect day to honor a boy whose mother made the ultimate sacrifice to deliver him! After his father died when Pancras was about 8, his uncle Denis raised him in Rome, where they both became Christians. As the **Emperor Diocletian's** tolerance of Christianity waned, he began to ban the Church. In 303, he issued a decree ordering the destruction of churches, scriptures, and Christians who refused to offer incense to Roman gods. Some say **Diocletian** tried to bring the boy and his uncle back to paganism, but they refuted his offers; in his rage over being rejected, he ordered them both to be beheaded in 303.

WITNESSES TO THE TRUTH. In the 6th Century, Pope Symmachus [reigned: 498 to 514], based on the tales still being told about the youth's bravery and faithfulness, built a basilica over Pancras' tomb, since, at that time, it was believed that anyone who falsely testified on Saint Pancras' revered relics would suffer some calamity, and since Bibles were not yet in print, oaths were sworn, even in civil courts, on Saint Pancras' relics. In the late 500's, when Pope Saint Gregory the Great sent Saint Augustine of Canterbury to Christianize England, he entrusted Saint Pancras' relics to him after England's first Bishop, Saint Augustine of Canterbury, built the first church in England, which he named in honor of Saint Pancras - and in which he enshrined Saint Pancras' relics. [That is why I said earlier that Saint Pancras PROBABLY never set foot in England, for who knows what part of his body or relic is encased in his church!]

A ROLE MODEL FOR TEENAGERS. Contrary to what some say, many of our young people DO stand up for **Gospel Truths**, traditional customs, and **Church Teaching**. The annual **March for Life** is teeming with teenagers; we have some very active adolescents in our Parish's ministries; I am deeply impressed by the number of teens who regularly go to **Mass** - and **Confession**. Some most courageously refute wokeism and radical sexual, gender, faithless or anti-faith forces in education and athletics, and other anti-biblical philosophies. May they know the intercession of Saint Pancras, their **Patron Saint**, who even as a teenager, defended the **Faith** and even gave his life for Christ and His Church. Saint Pancras, pray for our teens - and us.



TYPES OF SERVICES FIX IT VOLUNTEERS

- Repair minor electrical problems (such as faulty light switches) ■ Do minor carpentry repairs ■ Do minor plumbing (such as leaky faucets and running toilets)
- Change storm windows and doors ■ Weather stripping and caulking ■ Replace batteries in smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors ■ Change light bulbs ■ Change furnace filters and air conditioner filters ■ Install curtain and drapery hardware ■ Fix small appliances ■ Perform seasonal outside jobs




