





From the Pastor  
Pentecost - B  
May 19, 2024

**COME HOLY SPIRIT!** Today brings Eastertime 2024 to its climax: the Solemnity of Pentecost, the first Confirmation. The revised Roman Missal provides three sets of orations for the Conferral of Confirmation. We reflected on the other two sets: A, on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity 2022 and B, on Pentecost 2023. While Parishes celebrate the Confirmation of their teenagers throughout the year [ours was on Tuesday, April 16 with 63 Confirmandi], Pentecost is the preferred day to confirm adults, which our Bishop graciously delegates Pastors to do. Although we must use the orations for Pentecost today, please use the set of orations below to pray for those who have celebrated or will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation this year, their Sponsors, and their loved ones.

**Collect - For the Conferral of Confirmation - C**  
May the Paraclete who proceeds from you, we pray, O Lord, enlighten our minds and lead us into all truth, just as your Son has promised. Who lives and reigns with ... for ever and ever. Amen.

**THE HOLY SPIRIT LEADS US INTO ALL TRUTH.** With all due respect for fundamentalists or those who profess 'solo scriptura' - 'only Scripture,' who hold that all truths must be explicitly found in the Bible, that is NOT what Jesus promised! Before ascending into heaven, He promised that His Spirit - the Holy Spirit - would guide us in infallibly applying divine revelation or Sacred Scripture to each age's questions and concerns. For 2,000 years, we have been forming the Church's Tradition, with a capital 'T'. Lower case 'traditions' are the customs and devotions, rites and rituals, practices and procedures that come and go over time; these may or may not be based on biblical revelation but can never contradict it!

For instance, all Christians use the word *Trinity* to define how God is *Father, Son* and *Spirit*, and the words '*Original Sin*' and '*Bible*' - yet none of these words are in the Bible - nor is *Immaculate Conception, Assumption* or *Purgatory*. Under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, the Church 'coined' these terms to explain what IS in the Bible! So,

We need the Holy Spirit to lead us into all truth - and to inspire the term we use to define God's truth.

**Prayer over the Offerings - Conferral of Confirmation - C**  
Accept the oblation of your family, we pray, O Lord, that those who have received the gift of the Holy Spirit may keep safe what they have received and come to eternal rewards. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

**HOW TO "KEEP SAFE WHAT [WE] HAVE RECEIVED."** The first thought that comes to mind is: use it or lose it: even the Gifts of the Holy Spirit can become dormant or waste away when left unused. Like all gifts and talents, they must be exercised and enhanced, and the primary place to do this is at holy Mass. By hearing and reflecting on God's Word, receiving Jesus, truly present in the Eucharist, and being united with the Community of Believers, we can best support, sustain and stimulate the Sevenfold Gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom and understanding, counsel and fortitude, knowledge and piety, and with the fear of the Lord.

**Prayer after Communion - Conferral of Confirmation - C**  
Pour on us, O Lord, the Spirit of your love and, in your kindness, make those you have nourished by this one heavenly Bread one in mind and heart. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

**"ONE IN MIND AND HEART."** This line quotes a biblical description of the Infant Church: "The community of believers was of one heart and mind." [Acts 4:32] We all know that Christians in every age have had major disputes, differences of opinion, personality conflicts, and fallout from every other human imperfection. Some issues may not be rectified until we are all in heaven, and we may never see an open invitation for all to receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church. This does not mean that progress cannot be made; nor does it permit us to mistreat or malign those who do not profess all that the Catholic Church teaches and believes. However, it challenges us who regularly receive the Eucharist to grow in our own knowledge and understanding of our Faith so we can properly, "with gentleness and reverence" [1 Peter 3:16] explain it to others. What do you do to better attune your mind and heart to Catholicism?


Students enrolling in our program for the first time may register in person at the parish office Monday-Thursday, 9:00AM-Noon and 1:15-4:00PM.


