**'ISN'T IT ASCENSION THURSDAY?** On March 18, 2022, NJ's Latin Rite Bishops permanently transferred the Ascension of the Lord [which is its 'official' title, not Ascension Thursday!] to what was the 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter.

Locally, in 2020 & 2021, the Ascension was temporarily transferred to Sunday, due to the pandemic. While this may seem strange to us, MOST of the USA, and many other countries, transferred the Ascension to Sunday decades ago! While it is still on Thursday in Vatican City, Italy transferred it to Sunday in 1977. Perhaps a brief recap of Solemnities and holy days of obligation will help clarify all this.

**SOLEMNITIES ARE NOT ALWAYS HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION.** The Code of Canon Law [CCL] lists ALL Sundays, which includes Easter, and 10 holy days of obligation for the Universal Church: Christmas; Epiphany [01/06]; Ascension; The Body and Blood of Christ or Corpus Christi [the Thursday after Trinity Sunday]; The BVM, Holy Mother of God [01/01]; her Immaculate Conception [12/08] and Assumption [08/15]; Saint Joseph, Spouse of the BVM [03/19]; Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles [06/29] and All Saints Day [11/01]. However, with the Apostolic See's approval, each Conference of Bishops may suppress, as all Bishop Conferences in the USA did with the Solemnities of Saint Joseph and Saints Peter and Paul - or move them to Sunday, as they all did with Epiphany and Corpus Christi. Why did many, if not most conferences in the USA, move the Ascension to Sunday years ago?

The main reason for moving special days to Sunday is so more people can celebrate them. As our country becomes more secular or even anti-faith, getting off from work or school is not always possible on these days. And with the local shortage of Priests, scheduling enough Masses so all can easily fulfill the obligation is difficult, if not impossible. The distance needed to travel on work or school days to get to Mass is another reason for transferring them to a Sunday.

Because of all this, Hong Kong [so I'm told] has only 1 holy day of obligation besides each Sunday: *Christmas*. Canada has only two:

***Christmas* and *The BVM, Holy Mother of God*.** Hawaii also only has two: *Christmas* and *The Immaculate Conception*. The rest of the USA has 8 holy days of obligation ... but there are even exceptions to that rule!

When a holy day of obligation falls on a Sunday in Ordinary Time, it 'preempts' that Sunday; this is the case with the Assumption [08/15] and All Saints Day [11/01]. When holy days of obligation fall on a Saturday or Monday, the obligation is 'suspended' for two reasons. One, too many Masses in a short time would have to be celebrated by too few Priests; two, to avoid confusion over what the 'Anticipated' [commonly called 'Vigil'] Mass is celebrating. There are, however, two 2 exceptions to this rule:

*Christmas* and, in the USA, the Immaculate Conception [12/08], which has been our national Patronal Feast Day since 1846. These are always holy days of obligation, regardless of what day they fall on.

However, when December 8 is a Sunday, the Immaculate Conception is transferred to Monday, December 9, but the obligation to participate in holy Mass is not transferred. When the other major feasts: Saint Joseph, Spouse of the BVM [03/19] or the Annunciation [03/25], which is not even a holy day of obligation, fall on a Sunday or during Holy Week or the Octave of Easter, they are transferred to a weekday in Lent or Eastertime. But wait ... there's still more!

When other Solemnities fall on a Sunday: The Nativity of Saint John the Baptist [06/24] and All Soul's Day [11/02], which has no rank but is treated like a Solemnity, they preempt that Sunday. So does a Parish's Feast Day, unless it is a Sunday in Advent, Christmas, Lent or Eastertime or another Solemnity; in that case, it is transferred to another available day. And when one of the three Feasts of the Lord [a Feast is one rank below a Solemnity] falls on a Sunday, it, too, preempts the Ordinary Time Sunday. This occurs when The Presentation of the Lord [02/02]; Transfiguration [08/06]; Exaltation of the Holy Cross [09/14]; and Dedication of the Lateran Basilica [11/09], the Pope's Cathedral and the Mother Church of all Christendom, fall on Sunday. [Now you know!] I doubt any of this is on heaven's entrance exam [the ultimate Final Exam!], but it is good to know that our Catholic Faith is logical and highly organized!

So remember; next Sunday is the Ascension of the Lord!




