



From the Pastor
The Most Holy Body and
Blood of Christ - B
June 6, 2021

WE ARE THE BODY OF CHRIST. Bread and Wine; Wheat and Grape; Body and Blood. In the great mystery of the Eucharist, we who receive Christ's Sacred Body and Most Precious Blood are to become what - or rather,

WHO - we receive! So, it is impossible to separate Church from Holy Communion - True Believers from the Blessed Sacrament - the Faithful from the Feast of Life: the Gift of Finest Wheat and Blood outpoured for our salvation. So, as we celebrate 'Corpus Christi' - the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, it is right that we reflect on the Church, through whom we receive these Holy Gifts - and with whom we become these Holy Gifts.

Collect - The Holy Church: For the Church - B

O God, in the covenant of your Christ you never cease to gather to yourself from all nations a people growing together in unity through the Spirit; grant, we pray, that your Church, faithful to the mission entrusted to her, may continually go forward with the human family and always be the leaven and the soul of human society, to renew it in Christ and transform it into the family of God.

Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

A LEAVEN AND A SOUL. Leaven or yeast enables dough to rise. First, it must be mixed and kneaded to permeate all the dough, or there will be air pockets. Then, it must rest until it rises; it may be 'punched' or kneaded again to disperse air pockets. Finally, it is baked in heat, which forms its final product. No wonder Saint Paul and others used leaven or yeast as an analogy for how we Christians must share our gifts with the world.

First, our Faith must be interwoven into every aspect of our lives - for a Church that stays by itself or is removed from the world is basically useless. Then, her teachings and ideals must be reflected upon and pondered in the hearts and minds of all who wish to benefit from her. Often, it is only after persecution that she 'rises' to the occasion. Lastly, we who become what we receive can share the gift of her Gospel with others.

Prayer over the Offerings - For the Church - B

Receive with kindness the offerings we bring you, O Lord, and grant that your Church, which came forth from the side of Christ as he slept on the Cross, may ever draw her holiness from participation in this mystery, living by it always and responding worthily to her founder, Jesus Christ our Lord. Who lives and reigns for ever and ever. Amen.

FROM THE SIDE OF THE SLEEPING CHRIST. The marital imagery used to describe Christ's relationship to His Bride, the Church, is based on the Book of Genesis. After God put Adam into a deep sleep, he removed a rib from his side, and formed Eve, his bride, from it. During Easter-time, to begin the weekly Rite of Sprinkling, we note that "... from the pierced side of the crucified Christ flowed both blood and water, the source of the Church's sacramental life." For during His sleep in death, God formed us, Christ's Bride, from His side, torn open by a soldier's lance. This inspired the first Christians to see in a mother pelican, who rips open her own side to feed her young with her own flesh when no other food is available, an image of how Christ feeds us with His own Flesh and Blood. Some ancient Tabernacles were made in the form of a pelican for this reason! As I have often asked, how could we miss our weekly feeding by Christ with the great gift of Eucharist: His Sacred Body and Most Precious Blood?

Prayer after Communion - For the Church - B

Nourished by the Sacrament of your Son, we implore you, Lord, to make fruitful the work of your Church, for by it you constantly reveal the fullness of the mystery of salvation to the poor, whom you have called to an honored place in your eternal Kingdom. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

"BLESSED ARE THE POOR IN SPIRIT." While this Beatitude is not about a lack of money, what Jesus said about the rich is true: their overreliance on material things often keeps them from seeking the spiritual things they truly need. However, all of us, rich and poor alike, are invited to join in the weekly 'breadline' in which we are freely fed with Food from Heaven: Christ's Body and Blood.


Religious Education






