**From the Pastor
13th Sunday in
Ordinary Time - B
June 27, 2021**

MOTHER OF GOD. Many, if not most, who use the venerable title, 'Mother of God,' to call upon our Blessed Mother probably have no idea how controversial and widely misunderstood this title has been through the centuries. It makes Protestants - and some Catholics - believe we heretically 'worship' the Virgin Mother as if she's a goddess. It has led some to think she had supernatural powers - like being 'all-knowing' - as if she's divine. And it once led to an all-out brawl between two Bishops, one whom could have been honored today, June 27, his Feast Day, had today not been Sunday: Saint Cyril of Alexandria. More about him - and his fisticuffs - after praying the Collect for the holy Mass offered in his memory.

Collect- St. Cyril of Alexandria, Bishop & Doctor

O God, who made the Bishop Saint Cyril of Alexandria an invincible champion of the divine motherhood of the most Blessed Virgin Mary, grant, we pray, that we, who believe she is truly the Mother of God, may be saved through the Incarnation of Christ your Son. Who lives and reigns ... for ever and ever. Amen.

NESTORIANISM. To understand why Saint Cyril of Alexandria, Egypt, who was born between 370-380, and died on this date in 444, is so important, we must know who Bishop Nestorius was and the heresy he and others promoted. First, a snippet of Church history. Only after the Peace of Constantine in 313, when she was made 'legit' and her Bishops could meet in public, did the Church begin to resolve most theological and ecclesiological issues. First, she tackled questions like "Who is Jesus?" and "What is the Church?" Once she defined that Jesus is both True God and True Man, human and divine, in One Person, not in two Persons - and that the Church is His Body in the world today - they considered His birth and life, His Death and Resurrection - which created many questions about His Mother.

MOTHER OF JESUS - OR - MOTHER OF GOD? It soon became apparent that whatever they professed about Jesus would determine what we

profess about His Mother - and vice versa. If, as Nestorius and others taught, she was ONLY the mother of the HUMAN Jesus, then Jesus would be two distinct persons: one human, one divine - or one OR the other - but not both. That, in turn, would mean Jesus did not really die; He only 'faked' it - OR - as the religious leaders of His day accused Him: Jesus was guilty of blasphemy, forgiving sins, changing the Law of Moses, and doing other things only God can do!

So the Church came to the logical conclusion that Jesus is BOTH God and man, divine and human, and that His Mother was both Mother of the human Jesus AND the Mother of God ... that is, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity - not the Mother of God the Father or God the Holy Spirit. Greek Catholics even created a beautiful title just for her: 'Theotokos' or 'God-bearer' - or as we Latin/Roman Catholics call her: 'Mother of God.'

THE IMPORTANCE OF FAITH FORMATION. Where did Saint Cyril of Alexandria get all the theological knowledge to understand these mysteries and the position to promote them? He was the nephew of the Patriarch of Alexandria, Theophilus, who, as Egypt's main Bishop, oversaw Cyril's faith formation and took him with him to Church Synods and Councils. [Make sure you invite your children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews and others to faith formation events, too!] Upon Theophilus' death, Saint Cyril succeeded him; and he knew the faith so well that Pope Saint Celestine I [reigned: 422-432] named Saint Cyril 'papal legate' or his personal representative to the Council of Ephesus in 431 at which Mary was declared the Mother of God.

In his Letters, he refuted the heretical positions of Nestorius and his followers; these Letters, which we have to this day, are brilliant examples of theological thought. [Sadly, at one point, he and Nestorius literally 'fought' over these issues - which goes to show that Saints are not perfect!] Saint Cyril served as a Bishop for 32 years, which is reason enough to be canonized! He is often depicted in art holding a pen; with an image of the Blessed Virgin Mary holding the Child Jesus. Saint Cyril of Alexandria, Bishop & Doctor, pray for us!


Would you like to volunteer?


Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist

Please note that the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two year preparation. The student is enrolled usually in Grade 1 but a student may be 'year one' in any grade. The sacraments are then received in year two.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is also a two year preparation process. The student is enrolled in Confirmation Prep I for the first year and Confirmation Prep II for the reception of the sacrament.
