

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Marriage requires a time of spiritual preparation. According to the Common Policy adopted by the Bishops of New Jersey, this preparation requires attendance at a marriage preparation program (Pre-Canan) as well as sessions with the parish deacon or priest. Therefore, couples should make arrangements at the Parish Office one year before the planned wedding date and before finalizing any social plans.

From the Pastor
13th Sunday in
Ordinary Time - B
June 30, 2024

GOD DID NOT MAKE DEATH! This quote is from today's First Reading, from the Book of Wisdom [1:13]. It is accredited to King Solomon, but it was written a century or two before Christ. It is

also one of the disputed books, considered canonical - since the 300's - by Catholics and Orthodox, but not Protestants. It wrestles with, among other mysteries, the death of the young and blameless; these Readings are prescribed for use on the anniversary of the death and at Funerals for children. As you reflect on them [parts are in parenthesis if it is not the anniversary], pray for all who have suffered the loss of an unborn, newborn, young, teenage, young adult or fully mature adult child.

Collect - On the Anniversary - B - Outside Easter Time

Send down, we pray, O Lord, the lasting dew of your mercy on your servant N., [whose anniversary we commemorate,] and be pleased to grant him/her the company of your Saints. Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

WHAT'S ALL THIS 'DEWFALL' ABOUT? In Eucharistic Prayer II, the Priest prays: "Make holy ... these gifts ... by sending down your Spirit upon them like the dewfall." While this refers to manna, the bread from heaven, with which God fed our Jewish ancestors each day on their 40-year desert journey, it has a deeper meaning. Unlike rain, dew does not come down from above; it is formed as moisture already in the nearby air condenses into liquid form. Likewise, our God, who is not distant or aloof, is very near to us, closer to us than we even are to ourselves!

This, in turn, gives us great hope: for through His Church, the Lord is ever close to us! He comforts us through His holy word; He makes His home in us and strengthens us through the Gift of Eucharist; He embraces us through those who hold us in His holy Name; and He offers us His pardon and peace, hope and joy - to the living and the dead - when we gather to entrust to the Lord our loved ones - at their funeral - and in every prayerful remembrance of them, as we do when we pray these orations.

Prayer/Offerings - Anniversary - B - Outside Easter Time

Be attentive, O Lord, to our prayers for your servant N., [whose anniversary we observe today,] and through this sacrifice of conciliation and praise graciously add him/her to the company of your Saints. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

UN-CANONIZED SAINTS. Officially declaring 'Saints' and adding their names to the Church's roster of Saints began about 1,000 years ago; before that, 'Saints' were 'acclaimed' by local communities. Those who had a worldwide major impact were added to the **Universal Calendar**; some, like **Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton**, are only added to their **Country's or Regional's Calendar**; some are only added to their **Diocesan Calendar**. [Saint Theodore Guérin [Feast Day: October 3], is only an **Optional Memorial** in the **Diocese of Evansville, Indiana**, due to her lasting impact on the Church in southern Indiana.]

Everyone should have their own roster of 'Saints'; mark your calendars with your loved ones' earthly and [hopefully!] heavenly birthday, as most Saints are honored on their day of death or entrance into eternal glory. As we pray that God may soon admit them into the company of Saints [if they are not there already!], may they pray for us until we are all reunited ... forever!

Prayer after Communion - Anni.- B - Outside Easter Time

Just as you have lovingly accepted, O Lord, our prayers and sacrificial offerings for the soul of your servant N., so, we humbly entreat you: if any stain of sin has clung to him/her, may it be wiped away by your merciful forgiveness. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

THE POWER OF INTERCESSION. Some scoff at the Church's practice of interceding for others, but it moved Jesus more than once! He cured the man whose friends lowered him through a roof to get him to Jesus [Matthew 9:1-8; Mark 2:1-12; Luke 5:17-26] and a Roman Centurion's son when the pagan soldier - and some Jewish elders who vouched for the Centurion's goodness - asked Jesus to do so. Who can we help get into heaven by our prayerful intercession for them?

Registration for the 2024-25 Program Year

You may drop off your family registration form to the parish office. Forms for religious education registration are available only at the parish office. We ask that you please provide your child's Baptismal certificate if your child was not baptized in our parish. If your child is transferring into our program, we ask that a transfer be requested from the parish where your child previously attended.
