

From the Pastor

Independence Day

MOTHER OF GOD.

Monday, July 5, is the optional memorial of Saint Elizabeth of Portugal, whose Feast Day was originally July 8, but was moved during the 1960's

liturgical reforms to July 4. Since that is our Independence Day, her Feast Day in the USA is July 5. Born in 1271, she was aptly named after her great aunt, Saint Elizabeth of Hungary [1207-1231], for both women followed very similar paths to eternal glory. Both were married at a very young age, around 12; both became queens; both were distinguished for their service to the poor and needy; and both became Third Order Franciscans after the death of their husbands. More about Saint Elizabeth of Portugal and her exemplary life, which may be most helpful to many, after praying the Collect for the holy Mass celebrated in her honor.

Collect - St. Elizabeth of Portugal

O God, author of peace and lover of charity, who adorned Saint Elizabeth of Portugal with a marvelous grace for reconciling those in conflict, grant, through her intercession, that we may become peacemakers, and so be called children of God.

Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

QUEEN WITH A MERCIFUL HEART. Wedded to King Denis of Portugal when she was just 12, she had a difficult marriage; his extramarital affairs produced illegitimate children who vied with her children for royal privileges, and even for the throne itself. Her persistent prayers for his conversion, and her forgiveness of his indiscretions, paid off: he eventually abandoned his sinful lifestyle and became a more faithful Catholic. In his darker days, however, he even forbade her to share their resources - of which they had many - with the poor. According to what is probably a pious legend, as she headed out of the castle with an apron full of money for the needy, he stopped her and asked what she was carrying. When she revealed an apron full of roses - as she is often depicted in art - he let her go on her way to complete her mission of mercy.

A COURAGEOUS, FEARLESS QUEEN. More than once she literally 'stood in harm's way' to avert conflicts and avoid all-out war. While she could do little to quell the squabbles between rival nations, she entered the often-no-win situations caused by internal strife. When the son she bore with the king, Prince Alfonso, revolted against his father, King Denis, who openly preferred that his illegitimate son ascend to the throne, the future Saint literally stood between the two sides. At great personal risk, and potentially fatal peril, she pleaded for peace; since neither was willing to harm their respective wife and mother, they came to a compromise. Many families could use her intercession as they navigate the dangerous waters of family conflicts and internal strife! She also performed this treacherous role in many other spats; no wonder she is also depicted in art by the symbols of a peacemaker: a dove and an olive branch.

A QUEEN WHO MADE TIME FOR THE KING OF KINGS.

While a great perk of royal life is being free from a work schedule and other tasks, she devoted her 'free time' to spiritual and charitable exercises. Queen Isabel, as she was also known, attended daily Mass, took part in other liturgical rites, fasted, practiced penitential acts, and studied the doctrines of Catholicism. But she also served the poor, cared for the sick and dying, interceded for the down and out, and supported many charitable causes.

After her husband died and her children were out on their own, she entered a convent, living as simply as did the Sisters, and took vows as a Third Order or Lay Franciscan. Although Saint Francis of Assisi had only been dead for less than 100 years at that time, the influence of the Order he founded had even reached the highest levels of society. Soon after her death on July 4, 1336, numerous miracles were attributed to her intercession; she was canonized by Pope Urban VIII in 1625. Saint Elizabeth of Portugal is the patron saint of brides, peace, queens, falsely accused people and victims of adultery; she is also invoked for healing family rifts and for combatting jealousy. Saint Elizabeth of Portugal, pray for us!

Happy Independence Day! May God bless our great nation and may our laws be in accord with His natural law.

REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021-22 PROGRAM YEAR

All re-registrations have been mailed, if you did not receive one please contact us immediately. Parishioners who are registered in the parish as a family who have a child entering Grade 1 should have received a registration letter and form via the mail. If you have not registered as a family in the parish please do so immediately. You may then register for religious education for the 2021-22 program year. If your child was baptized in another church or another faith please provide us with a copy of the Baptism Certificate when registering for religious education. If your child was baptized at Saint Justin's Church the certificate will not be required.

Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist

Please note that the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two year preparation. The student is enrolled usually in Grade 1 but a student may be 'year one' in any grade. The sacraments are then received in year two.

Sacrament of Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation is also a two year preparation process. The student is enrolled in Confirmation Prep I for the first year and Confirmation Prep II for the reception of the sacrament.


JOHN PAUL II IN AMERICA: UNITING A CONTINENT


