

MARRIED 'SAINTED' COUPLES.

Our Church has more than 10,000 canonized or officially recognized Saints. However, the Church's canonization process is only about 1,000 years old; for

the first millennium, Saints were simply 'acclaimed' by the people and clergy. Of all our Saints, only about 500 were married; most, by far, were in **Holy Orders** or **Religious Life**. But there are only 10 - yes, only **TEN Married Couples** on our roster of Saints, and one couple was only added by Pope Francis in 2014! This week we honor one sainted couple: **Saint Henry** and his wife, **Saint Cunegundes** on his **Feast Day: July 13**; her **Feast Day is March 3**. Here are the others:

O God, whose abundant grace prepared Saint Henry to be raised by you in a wonderful way from the cares of earthly rule to heavenly realms, grant, we pray, through his intercession, that amid the uncertainties of this world we may hasten towards you with minds made pure.

Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever.

Amen.

KING HENRY II. Born in 972 into Bavarian and Burgundy royal families, **Saint Henry** was educated by a Bishop who is now canonized, **Saint Wolfgang of Regensberg**. As a devout and gifted student, young **Henry** was considered for the **Priesthood**. While his Bishop-Mentor's piety and charity left a lasting mark on him, he chose to follow in his father's political footsteps. In 995, one year after **Saint Wolfgang's** death, he became the Duke of Bavaria. The Church supported his accession to the throne as King of Germany in 1002, and, upon the death of his cousin, Otho III, he was elected the **Holy Roman Emperor**. In 999, he married **Saint Cunegundes**, but the couple were unable to conceive children.

A HOLY KING; BUT A MAN OF HIS TIMES. By today's standards, his cause for canonization would be most problematic. He and his wife, having no heirs, were most generous with their vast resources: they renovated or built churches and cathedrals; supported the education of clergy, charities and other causes, and even established the Diocese of Bamberg and its Cathedral where holy Mass would be perpetually offered for himself, his wife and their parents.

But, back then, the line between Church and State was nonexistent. The King, not the Pope, named Bishops, governed the local church, and set policies and procedures. He did not hesitate to use force, even deadly force, to accomplish his goals. He helped squash disturbances and disputes locally and in Rome. However, since potential Saints are NOT all-knowing, and must deal with events according to the customs and values of their time, what we now consider 'flaws' or 'disqualifying factors' do not apply to our ancestors, who did the best they could, given the limitations of their time. [Would that we, in today's world, adapt this most sensible mindset!]

A TOUGH LIFE. **Saint Henry** and his wife were not only plagued with childlessness, he also suffered with serious illnesses and an ailment that left him mostly immobile - all of which he managed to endure with prayer. He is patron saint of the childless and of those impaired by physical limitations. He died in 1024 and was canonized in 1146. **Saint Henry, pray for us!**

REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021-22 PROGRAM YEAR

All re-registrations have been mailed, if you did not receive one please contact us immediately. Parishioners who are registered in the parish as a family who have a child entering Grade 1 should have received a registration letter and form via the mail. If you have not registered as a family in the parish please do so immediately, you may then register for religious education for the 2021-22 program year. If your child was baptized in another church or another faith please provide us with a copy of the Baptism Certificate when registering for religious education. If your child was baptized at Saint Justin's Church the certificate will not be required.

Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist

Please note that the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two year preparation. The student is enrolled usually in Grade 1 but a student may be 'year one' in any grade. The sacraments are then received in year two.

Sacrament of Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation is also a two year preparation process. The student is enrolled in Confirmation Prep I for the first year and Confirmation Prep II for the reception of the sacrament.


