From the Pastor
16th Sunday in
Ordinary Time - B
July 18, 2021

OUTSTANDING ROOT. It is surely coincidence that the 1st Century Bishop and Martyr we honor this week, Saint Apollinaris of Ravenna, has a name similar to the 'Apollo' moon mission, and that man first landed on the moon on Saint Apollinaris' Feast Day: July 20, 1969. While our lunar explorations will never be forgotten or removed from history books, Saint Apollinaris almost got lost in space! Since there are so few historical records of him or his ministry, he was removed from the Church's calendar in the Second Vatican Council's liturgical reforms, to make room for more modern-day Saints. We'll explain how he got 'restored' to the calendar as an optional memorial - and why - after praying the Collect for Masses offered in his memory.

Collect - Saint Apollinaris, Bishop & Martyr

Direct your faithful, Lord, in the way of eternal salvation, which the Bishop Saint Apollinaris showed by his teaching and martyrdom, and grant, through his intercession, that we may so persevere in keeping your commandments as to merit being crowned with him. Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

WHAT WE PRESUME. Born in Antioch, Turkey, where Saint Peter the Apostle first served as Bishop before going to Rome, and where we were first called 'Christians' [Acts 11:26], tradition says that Saint Apollinaris was ordained a Bishop by our first Pope, Saint Peter, and was sent to Ravenna, on Italy's eastern coast, as its first Bishop. After the division of the Roman Empire in the 400's, Rome continued to rule the West, while Byzantium, now called Istanbul, ruled the East. Since the 600's, it has been under Muslim rule; over the centuries, radical Islamic forces destroyed many, but not all, Christian artifacts. [A cave in which Saint Peter gathered the Infant Church, which he reportedly dug out himself to be the first Gentile 'church,' still exists!]

In keeping with other historical records of the time, which meticulously detail the brutal and often fatal persecutions endured by the first Christians, and the frightful tortures inflicted on

Church leaders, we believe Saint Apollinaris suffered martyrdom after many painful torments. He was frequently beaten, cut with knives, had scalding hot water poured over his wounds, was bound and exiled to Greece to die, but was saved by shipwreck and returned to Ravenna.

WHAT WE KNOW. Although, as we stated, we have very little, if any, verifiable knowledge of Saint Apollinaris or his ministry, we do know this: his fame was well-known, and he was revered as a holy Bishop and Martyr venerated by many. In fact, two major churches were dedicated to his honor. In the older one, Saint Apollinaris in Classe, just outside of Ravenna, is a magnificent mosaic, seen above, of Saint Apollinaris with his hands in the 'orans' position and wearing Mass vestments. His halo depicts Sainthood; his white hair, wisdom; a bald spot or tonsure, Ordination to Priesthood; his lambswool pallium, the white stole-like band over his shoulders, still worn by Popes and other Metropolitan Archbishops, his Episcopal Consecration. That this mosaic was one of the few to survive wars, vandalism and decay is a tribute to his esteemed memory. It was dedicated on May 6, 549. The other church in his honor, just outside of Ravenna, the Basilica of Sant'Apollinare Nuovo [the 'new'], is where his mortal remains are still interred.

WHY IS HE BACK ON OUR CALENDAR? Pope Saint John Paul II may have had high hopes in returning his optional memorial to the Roman Catholic Church's calendar. The Polish Pontiff, as he was called, sought to end the millennium-long schism between the Catholic Church and the Orthodox Church, whose presence is far more prominent in Eastern Europe than it is locally. Saint Apollinaris predates the Catholic/Orthodox split, but he was of the Catholic Eastern or Byzantine Rite, which IS in union with Rome, but has many similarities to the Orthodox Church, who also honors him with a Feast Day. It also could be a way to promote peace between Christians and Muslims. For perhaps, if we learn more about each other, and celebrate what we have in common, all scandalous schisms and conflicts will be rectified. Saint Apollinaris, Bishop-Martyr, pray for us!

REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021-22 PROGRAM YEAR

All re-registrations have been mailed, if you did not receive one please contact us immediately. Parishioners who are registered in the parish as a family who have a child entering Grade 1 should have received a registration letter and form via the mail. If you have not registered as a family in the parish please do so immediately, you may then register for religious education for the 2021-22 program year. If your child was baptized in another church or another faith please provide us with a copy of the Baptism Certificate when registering for religious education. If your child was baptized at Saint Justin's Church the certificate will not be required.

Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist

Please note that the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two year preparation. The student is enrolled usually in Grade 1 but a student may be 'year one' in any grade. The sacraments are then received in year two.

Sacrament of Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation is also a two year preparation process. The student is enrolled in Confirmation Prep I for the first year and Confirmation Prep II for the reception of the sacrament.




