



**From the Pastor
17th Sunday in
Ordinary Time - B
July 25, 2021**

HELP MAKE A 'BLESSED' A 'SAINT!' While God invites all to attain heavenly glory, very few people are officially declared a 'Saint.' Here's the usual process. First,

person must die; then, 5 years must pass to let emotions die down before the Vatican's Congregation for the Causes of Saints even accepts the case; before 1983, it was a 50 year wait. Saint Teresa of Calcutta's wait was just 2 years, and she was canonized 19 years after her death; Saint John Paul II's wait to be canonized was merely 9 years. Once the case is accepted, the candidate is called a 'Servant of God' - and one who lived a heroic or very holy life may be called 'Venerable.'

Once a miracle [an inexplicable, instantaneous, scientifically-verified cure] is credited to one's intercession, they are declared 'Blessed' - but martyrs are immediately declared a 'Saint.' Which brings us to the man born on a farm in Oak Grove, Wisconsin in 1870, Bernard [Barney] Francis Casey, the 6th of 16 children born to Irish immigrants. He died on July 31, 1957; in 1997, Saint John Paul II declared him 'Venerable', and Pope Francis permitted his beatification to take place at Ford Field, Detroit, on November 18, 2017, declaring him a 'Blessed.' While he can help us by his intercession, could our intention be the miracle needed to 'seal the deal?' Pray the oration for his cause for canonization below, then we'll review his simple ministry.

Canonization Cause: Blessed Father Solanus Casey

O God, I adore you. I give myself to you.
May I be the person you want me to be,
and may your will be done in my life today.

I thank you for the gifts you gave

Father Solanus. If it is your will,
bless us with the canonization of Father Solanus so
that others may imitate and carry on his love for all
the poor and suffering of our world.

As he joyfully accepted your divine plans,
I ask you, according to your will, to hear my prayer
for... (add your intentions) ...

through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

"Blessed be God in all His designs."

"We must be faithful to the present moment, or we will frustrate the plan of God for our lives." As a boy, 'Barney' contracted diphtheria, which permanently damaged his voice and killed two of his siblings. He held a variety of jobs: lumberjack; hospital orderly; prison guard. As a street-car operator, he saw a drunken sailor kill a woman, which shocked him into acting on what he had long felt was God's call to be a Diocesan Priest. Rejected by the local Seminary, which taught in German and Latin, which no one spoke in his rural hometown, he was advised to enter Religious Life. He chose the Capuchins, a branch of Franciscans who embrace the radical call to poverty; with limited academic ability, he was ordained a 'Simplex' or simple Priest, who were not permitted to preach or hear confessions.

He was given the religious name 'Father Solanus' and served as the Friary's porter or doorkeeper and sacristan in Yonkers, NY and Huntington, IN. During the Depression, he fed thousands in Detroit's Capuchin Soup Kitchen. He lived by his quote [found at the top of this column] to live in the present moment, not his own plans and dreams which, in God's plan, turned out to be the way he would be recognized and known. For these 'menial jobs' put him in direct contact with those in need, who poured out their hearts to him, sought his advice, and were comforted by his 'ordinary' words and deeds. As he would say, "Blessed be God in all His designs!" - for the one who was not 'smart enough' to be a 'full' Priest is now on the road to Sainthood!

"Have faith in God, shake off excessive worry, and thank God ahead of time!" So strong was his faith and hope that he lived - and encouraged others to live - with total trust in God's plans for what is best for us. He promoted and modeled this 'simple' faith - which Jesus called a childlike trust in His Father - which brought peace and serenity to many. He is still available, via prayer, to all who need his gentle assurance and Christlike wisdom. So, use the prayer for the Cause of his Canonization to present your needs to God - and imitate his trust. [His Feast Day is July 30.] Blessed Father Solanus Casey, pray for us as we pray for and to you.

REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021-22 PROGRAM YEAR

All re-registrations have been mailed, if you did not receive one please contact us immediately. Parishioners who are registered in the parish as a family who have a child entering Grade 1 should have received a registration letter and form via the mail. If you have not registered as a family in the parish please do so immediately, you may then register for religious education for the 2021-22 program year. If your child was baptized in another church or another faith please provide us with a copy of the Baptism Certificate when registering for religious education. If your child was baptized at Saint Justin's Church the certificate will not be required.

Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist

Please note that the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two year preparation. The student is enrolled usually in Grade 1 but a student may be 'year one' in any grade. The sacraments are then received in year two.

Sacrament of Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation is also a two year preparation process. The student is enrolled in Confirmation Prep I for the first year and Confirmation Prep II for the reception of the sacrament.




