From the Pastor
18th Sunday in
Ordinary Time - B

**THE BREAD OF LIFE
DISCOURSE.**

Last week we began a 5-week consecutive proclamation of the 6th Chapter of John's Gospel: the Bread of Life Discourse. Every 3 years, we

proclaim Mark's Gospel, which is the shortest of the 4, so we enjoy a 5-week exposé on biblical Eucharistic Theology. Since we are also in the 3-year National Eucharistic Revival, our August bulletin articles will be on this Eucharistic theme.

Anyone who has distributed Holy Communion has had some awkward moments. We have had to offer 'just a blessing' or say a kind word to non-Catholics or non-Christians who just 'get in line' to receive what - or rather **Who** - they are not properly disposed to receive. [The OCIA: Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is open to all non-Catholics who wish to be prepared to receive the Blessed Sacrament.] After saying, "The Body of Christ," we have gotten responses like, "And also with you." - "And with your spirit." and "Thank you." Or we just get a **blank stare**, which clues us not to even offer the Eucharist to them!

Even more disturbing is: even some Catholics do these things! Some do not say "Amen" which makes us wonder if they know what they are doing. Some say "Amen" AFTER the Host is in their mouth, which could cause it to fall out. Some 'snatch' the Host from us, rather than make a throne for us to carefully place the Host. Some do not fully expose their tongue and expect us to reach INTO their mouth, or bite the Host with their teeth, or lick our fingers. This is not a slot machine. Forgive me for being so grossly honest, but this is the sad reality.

NONE of this is why the *USA's Bishops* called for a *National Eucharistic Revival*, but the '*Bread of Life*' Discourse provides an opportunity to reflect on our '*Holy Table Manners*.' For as a liturgical mantra says: "*Lex Orandi/Lex Credendi.*" This is translated as "*the law of prayer or how we worship is the law of belief or what we believe.*" Or in plain *English*: what we do or, do not do, shows what we believe, or do not believe. Let me give you a 'host' [pun intended]

of examples of what we should - or should not do - and why.

GENUFLECTING & KNEELING. We 'bend the knee' before His Real Presence in the Eucharist. When possible, we GENUFLECT or touch one knee to the floor and make the Sign of the Cross when we enter and leave the place where the Blessed Sacrament is reposed. If the Tabernacle is empty, the door is left open and the Sanctuary Lamp unlit [as it always is from before Holy Thursday's Mass until after Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil] and we **BOW** to the Altar. We KNEEL after the Santus for the rest of Eucharistic Prayer and after the Lamb of God Litany. As a common sign of reverence, the USA's Bishops direct us to STAND to receive Holy Communion, since we have already knelt twice to show our respect, and to avoid kicking or tripping others.

COMMUNION IN THE HAND. To receive in the hand, form a 'throne' with one hand under the other - raised high so the Minister can see how you wish to receive Holy Communion. BOW right before the Minister says, "The Body of Christ Say "Amen" and allow the Host to be **SECURELY PLACED** in the PALM of your hand; do not reach for or pinch it lest it be knocked to the floor. **WHILE** still standing before the Minister, place the Host in your mouth, and return to your place.

COMMUNION ON THE TONGUE. To receive on the tongue, extend your tongue out for hygienic reasons, so the Minister does not touch your lips, tongue, mouth or teeth. BOW as the Minister says, "The Body of Christ" - say "Amen" - and then extend your tongue so the Minister can place the Host on it. Then return to your place.

OTHER CONCERNS. Should a Host fall, the Minister normally picks it up unless it was already in your mouth; please be kind and hygienic: pick it up, since it was in your mouth, and consume it. Making a Sign of the Cross is optional; no need to show a sign of reverence to the Altar, Tabernacle or Crucifix for **JESUS HIMSELF IS IN YOU!** Barring an emergency or if performing another Ministry [i.e.: hand out our bulletins, etc.], all should return to their place, join in the Communion Chant, and pray. In the coming weeks: Eucharist is the Real Presence.

ATTENTION: BEWARE

It is sad that we have to warn about scams on Church grounds. Two weeks ago, several parishioners reported as they were leaving the 9:30 Mass there were people soliciting for money. It was reported that a woman was at the front doors and a man was at the side doors. They had signs asking for money. It was reported that on the same weekend scammers were at St. Joseph Parish doing the same thing. In the past, we have dealt with a group that sent out members to all Catholic Churches in our area simultaneously.

Please know that anyone collecting money or goods must first receive permission and would not be in the parking lot or at the outside doors of the Church. (Once a year, the Knights of Columbus collects for God's special children but they have permission to do so and they are a bona fide Church organization. If there has been no bulletin announcement or Pulpit announcement please do not open your purse or wallet.

Through your generosity, the Saint Vincent de Paul Society will help those who are truly in need and your donations of non-perishable foods are brought to the Food Pantry at St. Joseph Parish.

We do not know the intentions of these individuals. If you are approached by one of them or see them on the Church property, immediately call 911 and ask for police assistance. Please also inform one of the priests, deacons or an usher of the situation.

ARCHDIOCESE OF ONITSHA, NIGERIA

Preacher: Rev. Fr. Charles C. Muorah, PhD., STL, PGDE, LMFT Fr. Charles Muorah originally ordained for Onitsha Archdiocese, serving in Trenton Diocese since 2001 and incardinated into the Diocese of Trenton in 2011, is preaching the 2024 Mission Cooperation plan between Trenton Diocese and Onitsha Archdiocese, Nigeria.

The Church of Onitsha Archdiocese is in the east coast of Nigeria. Nigeria is the largest country in Africa with a population of about 220+ million people. Nigeria is approximately three times the size of Germany. Nigeria is about 55% Christian & the east coast is approximately 98% Christians. Onitsha Archdiocese has a geographical area of 536.9 square miles and a population of about 2.2 million people; Catholics are about 1.9 million.

The Church of Onitsha Archdiocese is blessed with rich vocations to the priesthood and religious life. It has 425 priests, 20 deacons to be ordained priest this year, and 132 seminarians. During his pastoral visit to Nigeria in February 1982, Pope John Paul II now a saint directed the Archbishop of Onitsha to start sending priests on mission to other parts of the world. Today, about 45 priests from the archdiocese serve in different parts of Nigeria, six in other dioceses in Africa, 27 in Europe, 63 in North America and about 15 in different parts of Asia. In the recent times, there is a renewed systematic attack on Christians by the Muslim radicals, especially the Boko Haram. Your generous gift will empower the Church of Onitsha Archdiocese to continue with its mission of defending the Christian faith and addressing the humanitarian crisis being generated by this modern form of persecutions of the Church and Christians. Part of the contribution will also fund the training of future priests and hospital projects.

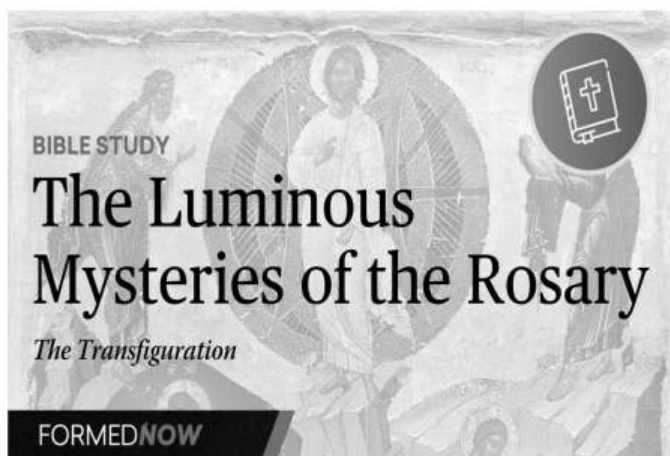
