**From the Pastor  
19<sup>th</sup> Sunday in  
Ordinary Time - B  
August 8, 2021**

**“QUIET! BE STILL!”** When Jesus said these words, which we heard a few weeks ago [12<sup>th</sup> Sunday in OT-B], the storm winds, billowing seas - and His disciples' fearful anguish - abated! When He

said, “Quiet! Be still!” was Jesus addressing the elements and/or His disciples? No matter how young or not so young we are, pounding thunderstorms and hurricane force gale winds can frighten us. So, Holy Mother Church provides special orations for her children to pray when the terrifying forces of nature strike us with fear and dread.

When we use an oration found in the section of the **Roman Missal** entitled ‘For Civil Needs:’ #34: In Time of Earthquake; #35: For Rain; #36: For Fine Weather, or the one found below, we recall a scene from ‘Fiddler on the Roof.’ When the beloved Rabbi is asked, “Rabbi, is there a proper blessing for the Czar?” he replies, “A blessing for the Czar, of course!” after which he solemnly chants, “May God bless and keep the Czar ... far away from us!” Likewise, the Church has a prayer for just about everything under the sun - and even above it. After praying oration #37: For an End to Storms, we will reflect on its biblical basis.

**Collect - II. For Civil Needs  
#37 - For an End to Storms**

O God, to whose commands all the elements give obedience, we humbly entreat you, that the stilling of fearsome storms may turn a powerful menace into an occasion for us to praise you.

Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

**GOD CONTROLS NATURE.** In a 70's commercial for Chiffon margarine, whenever ‘Mother Nature’ was tricked into thinking ‘manmade margarine’ was ‘natural butter,’ she struck up a storm and nastily declared, “It’s not nice to fool Mother Nature!” While that’s NOT the image of God presented in sacred Scripture, God does use nature for His own purposes. Some examples are: the Flood in Noah’s time; the plagues in the days of Moses when water turned to blood, when frogs, lice, flies, and locusts, pestilence, boils, hail and darkness, wreaked havoc, the Red Sea dried up, and a hailstorm killed more enemy troops than did Israel’s army. [See Joshua 10:11]

**“GOD’S USE OF NATURE IN THE 150 PSALMS.** The poetic Book of Psalms presents a plethora of the powerfully potent ways God puts the forces of nature to His own use. There are countless indirect references, but here are some direct ones. God “rains upon the wicked ... a scorching wind their allotted cup.” [Psalm 11:6] “The LORD thundered from heaven ... shot his lightning bolts and dispersed them.” [18:14-15] “You still the roaring of the seas ... the roaring of their waves.” [65:8] “Pursue them with your tempest; terrify them with your storm-wind.” [83:16] “You rule the raging sea; you still its swelling waves.” [89:10] “It is he who raises storm clouds from the end of the earth, makes lightning for the rain, and brings forth wind from his storehouse. [He] sent signs and wonders against you, Egypt, against Pharaoh and all his servants.” [135:7, 9] So, God is clearly in control of nature, and uses it to show us, by comparison, His might and power, to warn us of His anger, and comfort us with His blessings - which leads us to this special oration.

**“AN OCCASION FOR US TO PRAISE YOU.”** We can all recall as children, fleeing into our parent’s bedroom during violent thunderstorms to seek comfort and security. Does God permit storms to ‘scare’ us so that, with the childlike faith which Jesus said we needed to enter into the Kingdom of God, we learn to run into our Heavenly Father’s arms for the protection He alone can grant? Does the Lord display the powerful forces of the natural world to give us a glimpse of the supernatural world? While it is good that we are deepening our ecological understanding of how important the natural world is, do we also strive to deepen our theological understanding of how important it is to rely on supernatural grace?

Just as Jesus revealed Himself more fully to His disciples by calming storms, changing water into wine, curing diseases and ailments, may He reveal His awesome power to us through nature. May every storm, every clap of thunder, and every bolt of lightning, stir our minds and hearts to worship the God who creates and controls all things. May every rainbow assure us of the beauty that awaits us when life’s many storms are finally and mercifully ended.

## **REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021-22 PROGRAM YEAR**

All re-registrations have been mailed, if you did not receive one please contact us immediately. Parishioners who are registered in the parish as a family who have a child entering Grade 1 should have received a registration letter and form via the mail. If you have not registered as a family in the parish please do so immediately, you may then register for religious education for the 2021-22 program year. If your child was baptized in another church or another faith please provide us with a copy of the Baptism Certificate when registering for religious education. If your child was baptized at Saint Justin's Church the certificate will not be required.

### **Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist**

Please note that the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two year preparation. The student is enrolled usually in Grade 1 but a student may be 'year one' in any grade. The sacraments are then received in year two.

### **Sacrament of Confirmation**

The Sacrament of Confirmation is also a two year preparation process. The student is enrolled in Confirmation Prep I for the first year and Confirmation Prep II for the reception of the sacrament.

**Giving thanks for God's blessings**

Did you know that this August marks the 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Diocese of Trenton?

In 1881, Pope Leo XIII established the Diocese of Trenton to serve the Catholics of the southern part of New Jersey and named Father Michael J. O'Farrell of New York as its first bishop. At the time, the Diocese had 68 churches, 23 parochial schools and 51 priests spread out across Burlington, Mercer, Monmouth and Ocean Counties, as well as all of the territory that is now part of the Dioceses of Camden and Metuchen. 
#### EDITH STEIN: THE SEVENTH CHAMBER
