**From the Pastor  
Assumption of the Blessed  
Virgin Mary  
August 15, 2021**  
[Preempts the 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday  
in Ordinary Time - B]

**“AN EARTHLY KING WHO  
HONORED THE QUEEN OF  
HEAVEN.** It is most  
appropriate that as we cele-  
brate the **Assumption** of our  
**Blessed Mother** into heaven

that we reflect on the sainted monarch honored later this week. Although he died on **August 15, 1038**, his **Feast Day** in Hungary is **August 20**, which is also their **Constitution** or **Foundation Day**, which they celebrate in ways like our **Fourth of July**. In the USA, **Saint Stephen of Hungary's** **Feast Day** is **August 16**. But what makes reflecting on him today so appropriate?

Although the **Assumption**, which the **Eastern Churches** call her ‘**Dormition**’ or ‘**falling asleep**’ and entering into heaven, was only defined in 1850, it was a **Marian Holyday** in 1038, when, on the day he died, **Saint Stephen of Hungary** made this solemn proclamation: “**To thee, O Queen of heaven, and to thy guardianship, I commend the holy Church, all the bishops and the clergy, the whole kingdom, its rulers and inhabitants; but before all, I commend my soul to thy care.**” This gave new meaning and purpose to this **oldest** of all **Marian Holydays**, for records show that it was already being celebrated in 529. After praying the oration for the holy Mass offered on his optional memorial, we'll give some highlights of the life of **Saint Stephen of Hungary**.

**Collect - Saint Stephen of Hungary**

Grant your Church, we pray, almighty God,  
that she may have Saint Stephen of Hungary,  
who fostered her growth while a king on earth,  
as her glorious defender in heaven.  
Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever.  
Amen.

**UNLIKELY MAKINGS OF A SAINT.** Born into a pagan family [circa 969-975], his mother, based on a vision, named him after our **First Martyr: Saint Stephen**. His father was the chief of one of the tribes that eventually became the nation of Hungary. Baptized at the age of 10 with his father, he was the first in his family to be a devout Catholic. To succeed his father, he had to battle family and pagan foes who opposed use of Christianity to unite the many tribes that became

“Hungary. He married Gisela, sister of the Holy Roman Emperor, **Saint Henry** and on December 25, 1000 or January 1, 1001, he received a crown, a personal gift from Pope Sylvester II, and became Hungary's first king.

**THE CROWN BECOMES A CROSS.** His efforts to suppress paganism and promote **Christianity** were opposed, often very violently, which he responded to in kind, as was the norm in those days. He established churches and monasteries, ordered a ‘tithes’ to support Clergy and Religious Sisters and Brothers, and defended the rights of the faithful. Since he had a special devotion to our **Blessed Mother** he oversaw the construction and support of many shrines dedicated to her. And there are no records of him not practicing what he preached and promoted.

**PERSONAL CROSSES.** Only one of his children lived to adulthood, but his son and presumptive heir died in a hunting accident in 1031. He might be comforted to know that both he and that son, **Saint Emeric**, were both canonized in the same ceremony in 1083. However, his son's death led to horrific in-fighting among his relatives over who would succeed him; some of his nephews even tried to kill him! These ‘crosses’ led him to become the patron saint of, among other things: against the death of children; bricklayers; masons; stonecutters; and kings. He is often depicted in art kneeling before our **Blessed Mother**, presenting her with the crown and other symbols of his kingly reign.

**A SAINT MOST RELEVANT TO US.** As **Saint John Paul** said of him: “**At the dawn of the [new] millennium, the figure of King Saint Stephen stands out**” ... for he ... “**founded the State on the firm rock of Christian values ... [with] deep unity with the Chair of Peter and bound by close ties to other European countries, which shared the same Christian culture.**” Would that these words, these ideals, be said of our great country, which seems to be divorcing herself from her **Christian** roots and ways. Yet there is reason to hope, for our **Blessed Mother**, under her title **The Immaculate Conception** is the patroness of the USA - and with the USA on **HER** side, we will not falter! **Saint Stephen of Hungary, pray for us!**

### **REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021-22 PROGRAM YEAR**

All re-registrations have been mailed, if you did not receive one please contact us immediately. Parishioners who are registered in the parish as a family who have a child entering Grade 1 should have received a registration letter and form via the mail. If you have not registered as a family in the parish please do so immediately, you may then register for religious education for the 2021-22 program year. If your child was baptized in another church or another faith please provide us with a copy of the Baptism Certificate when registering for religious education. If your child was baptized at Saint Justin's Church the certificate will not be required.

#### **Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist**

Please note that the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two year preparation. The student is enrolled usually in Grade 1 but a student may be 'year one' in any grade. The sacraments are then received in year two.

#### **Sacrament of Confirmation**

The Sacrament of Confirmation is also a two year preparation process. The student is enrolled in Confirmation Prep I for the first year and Confirmation Prep II for the reception of the sacrament.

**Did you know that this August marks the 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Diocese of Trenton?**  
 In 1881, Pope Leo XIII established the Diocese of Trenton to serve the Catholics of the southern part of New Jersey and named Father Michael J. O'Farrell of New York as its first bishop. At the time, the Diocese had 68 churches, 23 parochial schools and 51 priests spread out across Burlington, Mercer, Monmouth and Ocean Counties, as well as all of the territory that is now part of the Dioceses of Camden and Metuchen. 
