

**From the Pastor

**EARTHQUAKE!**

One of the most devastating of all natural disasters is the dreaded and often deadly **earthquake**, which, unlike violent storms, usually strikes without warning. While I have never experienced a major earthquake, I have felt a few tremors. I was totally unaware of any of the ground movements caused over the years by New Jersey's Ramapo fault. However, I did feel the wobbly effects of, and saw a chandelier slightly swinging, after the 2011 earthquake centered in Virginia, which did damage to the Washington Monument and the National [Episcopal] Cathedral.

But many others, in other parts of the world, have not been so blessed. So, for them, and in the name of all who suffer the effects of the shifting Earth, we offer the oration provided in the section of the **Roman Missal** entitled 'For Civil Needs: #34: In Time of Earthquake.' [In past bulletin articles we reflected on the others in the section: #37: For an End to Storms [08/08], #35: For Rain [08/29] and #36: For Fine Weather [09/05].

**Collect - II. For Civil Needs**

**#34 - In Time of Earthquake**

O God, who set the earth on its firm foundation, spare those who are fearful and show favor to those who implore you, so that, with all dangers of earthquake entirely gone, we may continue to experience your mercy and serve you in thankfulness, safe under your protection.

Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

**ARE WE TRULY ON 'TERRA FIRMA'?** Our ancestors in faith, who believed that God fixed the earth on its foundation, so it can never be shaken" [Psalm 104:5] must have been terrified when '**terra firma**'- the '**firm earth**'- trembled and rocked. In their worldview, as a footnote in the **New American Bible, Revised Edition** for the above quote explains, they believed: "God places the gigantic disk of the earth securely on its foundation and then, as a warrior, chases away the enveloping waters and confines them under, above, and around the earth." While they lacked

our scientific knowledge and made erroneous assumptions about the Earth, we cannot dismiss the Bible. For it is primarily a **theological** work that uses poetry and psalms, numeric symbolism and other literary devices, and 'adapts' science and history to teach us about God and His plan for our world.

The Bible also admits that what we thought to be 'immovable' does, in fact, move; however, it also says: "Thus we do not fear, though earth be shaken and mountains quake to the depths of the sea, though its waters rage and foam and mountains totter at its surging." [Psalm 46: 3-4] So we can learn an important lesson about societies and governments, families and friendships - and the Church - when these things, which we thought were on a firm rock foundation, show signs of falling apart. For as God securely holds the Earth in place, He also holds all who put their trust in Him. But to carry 'earthquake-ology' one step further ...

They say the safest places during an earthquake are in a secure doorway or under a sturdy table. Now let's carry that imagery one step further, into 'liturgical lingo.' First, the Church is likened to the doorway between God and man, heaven and earth, the spiritual and natural worlds. So, when our world seems to be falling apart, it makes sense to seek security in the Church: the doorway between this world and the next.

Second, the Altar around which we gather to offer the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is likened to a table. It is also referred to as the Rock from which we are fed and water as Saint Paul wrote: "All ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink, for they drank from a spiritual rock that followed them, and the rock was the Christ." [1 Corinthians 10:3-4] Doesn't it also make sense to come to the Altar [but not under it!] when the world around us seems to be crumbling and falling apart?

As we sing in **Dan Schutte's 1975 hymn**, 'Though the Mountains May Fall,' may we find in our God and in our faith "a shelter for all who call on [God's] name." And may we always generously reach out to help all who suffer from a devastating **earthquake** or any other disaster and always keep them in our prayers..

#### **REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021-22 PROGRAM YEAR**

*Please note that classes will be starting so please register immediately!*

All re-registrations have been mailed, if you did not receive one please contact us immediately. Parishioners who are registered in the parish as a family who have a child entering Grade 1 should have received a registration letter and form via the mail. If you have not registered as a family in the parish please do so immediately, you may then register for religious education for the 2021-22 program year. If your child was baptized in another church or another faith please provide us with a copy of the Baptism Certificate when registering for religious education. If your child was baptized at Saint Justin's Church the certificate will not be required.

#### **Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist**

Please note that the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two year preparation. The student is enrolled usually in Grade 1 but a student may be 'year one' in any grade. The sacraments are then received in year two.

#### **Sacrament of Confirmation**

The Sacrament of Confirmation is also a two year preparation process. The student is enrolled in Confirmation Prep I for the first year and Confirmation Prep II for the reception of the sacrament.


