From the Pastor
27th Sunday in
Ordinary Time - B
October 3, 2021

“ESTABLISHED ON THE CROSS.” When we begin a project or start a journey, we want ‘everything to be right and in its proper place,’ which we believe will give us the best shot at attaining success. How-

ever, that is not how the mind of God works - nor the mind of one of our newest Saints worked. Born in Brittany, France on October 2, 1798, Saint Theodore Guérin, died on May 14, 1856, was beatified by Saint John Paul II on October 25, 1998, and canonized on October 15, 2006, by Pope Benedict XVI. On October 22, 1840, she and five other Sisters came to the USA; on July 4, 1841, they established the Academy of Saint Mary-of-the-Woods in the Diocese of Vincennes, Indiana. To say that this endeavor, and her whole life, was “established on the cross,” is an understatement! We’ll explain that after offering the prayer we cannot use this year, since her Optional Memorial [today] falls on a Sunday.

Collect - Saint Theodore Guérin, Virgin

Loving God, in Saint Theodore Guérin you have given us an example of a religious woman who trusted deeply in Providence.

Through her intercession, inspire us to dedicate our lives to proclaiming the Gospel through works of love, mercy, and justice. Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

THE CROSS OF PERSECUTION. After the 1789-1799 French Revolution, anti-clerical and anti-Catholic sentiments - and violent actions - were rampant in the **Eldest Daughter of the Church**. [This title, given to France due to her unbroken tie since the 2nd Century to the Bishop of Rome, may sadly no longer be applicable.] Baptized Anne-Thérèse, she was catechized by a cousin who was a seminarian and who lived in hiding in her family’s home. He gave her a theological formation enjoyed by very few women in those days. Her father was murdered by robbers when she was 15; this shocking crime so devastated his wife that Anne-Thérèse spent her youth caring for her mother and sister. But at 25, she entered the Sisters of Providence and was given the religious name Sister Theodore.

“THE CROSS OF CHURCH LIFE & MINISTRY. As if the challenges of communal life were not enough of a cross, she faced constant threats of harm and death from those who sought to destroy convents, churches and religious sites. She endured anti-Catholic rhetoric and actions. When she adapted her Community’s Rule, which governed their way of life, to the situations and challenges they had to face in America, her Bishop excommunicated her! [She was restored to the Church’s good graces by his successor.] It is ironic that some of the greatest Catholics have suffered at the hands of the very same Church they so loved and strove to serve; go figure!

Just as the earthly life of Jesus seemed to end in dismal defeat when He died on the Cross, so did the ministry of Mother Theodore. Even after overcoming anti-Catholic bigotry, the all-too-common financial struggles faced by religious groups, and other woes, even nature seemed to turn against her. She was nearly shipwrecked during a storm, and suffered from ill health. She and her Sisters endured the harsh, Midwest winters, and a devastating fire destroyed their entire harvest, leaving them destitute and hungry. These are just some of her many crosses!

A SAINTLY ROLE MODEL. Throughout it all, Saint Mother Theodore Guérin remained upbeat and positive; she cheerfully encouraged her Sisters to embrace every sorrow as a prelude to the immense joy promised by God to those who endure. She never allowed anger or bitterness, hopelessness or vengeance, to fester within her. Nor did she confuse the human imperfections of Church leaders with the Lord who, despite our limitations, works His grace in and through us. As Mother Theodore would say, “With Jesus, what shall we have to fear?”

If we simply adopted that as our motto, we would not only be honoring her, but our own life would be much more peaceful. In a world of so much negativity, don’t we need the example of a Saint who drew out the best in people, enabled them to attain more than they thought possible, and who beautifully mirrored the life-giving power of the Cross? Saint Theodore Guérin, pray for us!

*Ushers facilitate collection of the contributions






