

**From the Pastor  
29<sup>th</sup> Sunday in  
Ordinary Time - B  
October 17, 2021**

**GOD'S CHURCH GIVES US  
WHAT TO SAY AND  
PRAY.**

Who has not been at a loss for words when trying to comfort a mourner after the sudden, unexpected death of a loved one? Whose faith is not

shaken when shocked by a loved one's unanticipated death? In these times, the consoling words of Holy Mother Church are most helpful. The Roman Missal's section of orations for Funeral Masses and Masses for the Dead has numerous prayers for particular challenging situations. Among them are: #7: For a Young Person and #8: For One Who Suffered a Long Illness; the Order of Christian Funerals also offers super-sensitive prayers for Baptized or Unbaptized Infants; Children, Suicide Victims, etc. This week we reflect on the special Collect #9: For One Who Died Suddenly.

**Collect - #9: For One Who Died Suddenly**

Show us, Lord, the immense power of your goodness, that, as we weep for our brother (sister) N., taken from us by a sudden death, we may be confident that he (she) has passed over into your eternal company. Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

**NO ONE KNOWS THE DAY OR THE HOUR!** We cannot say we have not been warned that 'the end' - of the world, of our own life, or of anyone else's life - may come suddenly and unexpectedly. Jesus warned us, many times, to be watchful and ready, to be prepared, and not to wait until the end when it may be too late. "Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour." [Matthew 25:13]. However, Jesus also assured us that He will be with us always, and Saint Paul said: "[God] wills everyone to be saved" [1 Timothy 2:4a] - so we can always have hope ... but there's even more!

Based on her two-thousand-year reflection on sacred Scripture and divine revelation, Holy Mother Church assures us that the living can assist the dead in gaining the gift of eternal life in heaven. As the heart-wrenching exasperation of both Martha and Mary over Jesus' absence during their brother Lazarus' illness and death

"clearly shows, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." [John 11:21, 32] - our prayerful intercession for the dead WORKS! So, we should never despair of God's ability to save those who die, even with sins on their souls.

**"CONSOLE ONE ANOTHER WITH THESE WORDS."** In his first Letter to the Thessalonians [4:18], Saint Paul ends his explanation on how the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus gives us great hope that all might be saved with the above quote: "Console one another with these words." Catholic Christians fulfill the command to 'put your words into action' through our Funeral Rites. Those who seek to expedite or avoid the grief process that comes with the death of a loved one, especially one taken suddenly - by scaling back or not having any Funeral Rites - are only cheating themselves.

**LET THE LITURGY CONSOLE YOU.** As we wrote in previous articles, so-called 'Celebrations of Life' should NEVER take the place of a proper funeral; ideally, there should always be a Funeral Mass - with the body present - so the Church can offer the DEAD - AND THE LIVING - all the signs that comfort and console us. While cremation IS permitted, the Church prefers that it be done, when possible, AFTER the Funeral Mass and other Services so the deceased's body can be sprinkled with holy water, covered in a white cloth again, as we were at Baptism, reverenced with incense, etc.

**TRUST IN GOD ... AND LET GO!** There are no easy ways or short cuts when it comes to parting - FOR NOW - with our deceased loved ones. We say 'for now' because God promises to reunite us all in the eternal joys of His Kingdom. As many experienced during Covid restrictions, when funerals were delayed or forbidden: we need to, we must say goodbye - and let go - to be truly healed. While this is even more difficult with sudden, unexpected death, it is, as with all things, possible with God's grace via the Church. Some Parishes offer Bereavement Groups that enable mourners to journey together. [Ours began last month; see the bulletin for more info.] May we always seek out and use all the Church offers to help us in times of need.




