





**From the Pastor  
30<sup>th</sup> Sunday in  
Ordinary Time - B  
October 24, 2021**

**LET GOD BE YOUR DRIVER.** As we have explained before, when the feast day of a Saint falls on a Sunday, we usually skip it - unless it is that Parish's Patron Saint, or that

community has a strong devotion to him or her. Although today, October 24, is the day on which Saint Anthony Mary Claret died in 1870, we do not celebrate his Feast Day this year. [To my knowledge, only one Parish in NJ is named for him, in Lakewood, in our Diocese of Trenton.] However, with all that has been going on in Cuba, where he once served as Archbishop, and with the increasing rejection of Christianity by many, we need to reflect on his life and seek to imitate his example of trusting that God will invite us to go where He knows we need to be. We begin by seeking his intercession as we pray his Feast Day's Collect.

**Collect - Saint Anthony Mary Claret, Bishop**

O God, who for the evangelization of peoples strengthened the Bishop Saint Anthony Mary Claret with admirable charity and long-suffering, grant, through his intercession, that, seeking the things that are yours, we may earnestly devote ourselves to winning our brothers and sisters for Christ. Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

**LET GO AND LET GOD.** Born into a poor family in Spain in 1807, *Anthony Claret* was the fifth of eleven children. They supported themselves as weavers, a family business that gave him the corporate and practical experience he would need later in life. His pious family prayed the *Rosary* each day, which sowed the seeds of his Vocation and his devotion to our *Blessed Mother*. He applied to the *Jesuits* and *Carthusians* but was too sickly for their intense novitiate; at his Bishop's suggestion, he trained for the *Diocesan Priesthood*, and was ordained when he was 28 which, back then, was considered a 'delayed' vocation! For 10 years, he lead parish missions and served as a popular Retreat Master. His hopes to enter religious life were eventually fulfilled when, at 42, he founded his own

"Religious Order: the Claretians, who emphasize the Eucharist and Marian Devotions."

**ANOTHER NEW CHAPTER.** Back then, the reigning monarch often assigned Bishops, and around 1850, Queen Isabella II named him the Archbishop of Santiago, Cuba which Spain owned. With no episcopal shepherd for 14 years, the Clergy were inept, Parishes were in shambles, and corrupt colonists used the Church to enslave the Cubans. Archbishop Claret used his business experience - and his preaching against slavery and racism - to help people break free from tyranny, but he enraged the exploiters. Numerous assassination attempts were made on his life, one which left him seriously wounded.

**AND ANOTHER NEW CHAPTER.** For his safety and her own needs, the Queen returned him to Spain as Chaplain to the royal family, serving as her Confessor and as Catechist for her children. He agreed, IF she let him engage in ministry outside the palace, which enabled him to write over 200 books and pamphlets on Catholicism. In 1868, he was exiled to Rome with the royal family, but God's timing was perfect: he spoke at Vatican Council I [1869-1870] which defined Papal Infallibility. His staunch defense of the Pope's ability to infallibly declare matters of faith and morals [not everything he says about anything!] was invaluable to the Council Fathers. After the Council, his initial hope finally came true: he entered a Cistercian Monastery, living in quiet solitude until his death in France in 1870.

He was canonized by Pope Pius XII in 1950, the same year the Pope dogmatically declared the *Assumption of Mary*; to whom Saint Anthony was so devoted. As was once customary, female and male Religious and Clergy added 'Mary' or an 'M.' to their name to honor her. Back when the Dominican Sisters who taught me had 'religious names,' we had Sister M. Ancille, Sister M. Emmanuel, Sister Mary Leonard, to name a few..

**EVANGELIZATION: IT'S EVERYONE'S DUTY!** The best way to honor Saint Anthony Claret is to do as he did: evangelize in anyway we can everyone, wherever God sends us! So, spread your Catholic faith at home, at work, play, and in every day life activities. Saint Anthony Mary Claire, pray for us!


### LEARN THE CONFESSIONS OF ST. AUGUSTINE, SIX-PART SERIES


