**From the Pastor**  
Lord Jesus Christ,  
King of the Universe - A  
[Last Sunday in Ordinary Time]  
November 22, 2020

**"VIVA CRISTO REY", "LONG  
LIVE CHRIST THE KING!"**

During last year's Parish Pilgrimage to Our Lady of Guadalupe's Shrine in Mexico, we visited the Shrine of the Priest executed in 1927 on what is now his **Feast Day**:

**November 23: Saint Miguel Agustín Pro Juárez.**

I took the above photo while standing before the reliquary that contains his remains, over which is his portrait and the symbol of the Jesuits: a blazing sun, the letters IHS, 'pierced' by a cross shaped like a sword, and 3 nails. Our brief visit still haunts me, which you will understand after praying the Collect for the Mass offered in his honor and reading about this brave, 'Jesuit Jester' martyr.

**Collect - St. Miguel Agustín Pro, Priest & Martyr**

Our God and Father, who conferred upon your servant Blessed Miguel Agustín Pro the grace of ardently seeking your greater glory and the salvation of others, grant, through his intercession and example, that by faithfully and joyfully performing our daily duties and effectively assisting those around us, we may serve you with zeal and ever seek your glory.

Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. **Amen.**

**CALLED TO SERVE OTHERS.** Born on January 13, 1891, the eldest boy of 11 children, the future Saint was an intensely spiritual, cheerful boy with a mischievous sense of humor. After pulling a stunt that knocked him out, he awoke and asked for some 'cocol' [his favorite sweet bread] which became his nickname - and 'code name' during his clandestine ministry. After an older sister he was very close to entered a convent, he followed his own desire to serve the Lord. He gave up his position in his father's lucrative business, left the many señoritas who adored him, and entered a Mexican Jesuit Novitiate in 1911. When the anti-Catholic government closed all religious houses, he and his Jesuit brothers fled to California; he finished his seminary formation in Spain in 1914 and was ordained a Priest in Belgium in 1925.

**FROM BAD TO WORSE.** Although he suffered from a severe stomach disease, uncured even after 3 operations, his superiors allowed the ailing Miguel to return to Mexico in 1926. The 1917 Mexican Constitution forbade the public wearing of any clerical garb; in his first visit to Mexico, a special indult was passed to allow **Saint John Paul II**, his entourage, and others to wear clerics! Celebrating Sacraments or any religious rite was punishable by death; churches were closed; those who possessed religious artifacts were harassed or lost their jobs. The 'underground' Church barely survived; many Christians were executed.

**THE JESUIT JESTER.** To minister to the faithful-in-hiding, **Saint Miguel** donned clever disguises. He wandered the streets at night as a beggar, entering homes to baptize, bless marriages and celebrate Mass. Dressed in a business suit, with a fresh flower in his lapel, he brought provisions to the poor. Clad in a policeman's uniform, he got into prisons to bring Viaticum to the condemned. He even stopped at headquarters to get directions and returned later to warn the police of a Priest on the loose!

**HE GOT THE LAST LAUGH.** In 1927, he was betrayed, arrested, and accused of helping an assassination attempt on Mexico's President; with no legal process, he was condemned to death. As he stood before the firing squad he chose to face without a blindfold, he forgave them, knelt in prayer, stood with arms outstretched in the form of a cross with rosary beads in hand, and exclaimed, "**Viva Cristo Rey**" - "**Long live Christ the King!**" The Mexican government even invited the media to record - and publicize - his execution to scare and silence Catholics ... but ...

In one of the largest crowds that had ever gathered in Mexico City, 30,000 people viewed his funeral cortege - to the shock of government officials. Many chanted "**Viva Cristo Rey**" as his body passed by. The Catholic Church would not be silenced! Could he have ever imagined that just 52 years later, in full papal regalia, **Saint John Paul II**, on his first of 4 trips to Mexico, would be greeted by the Mexican President and publicly celebrate Mass? How do we honor

**Christ the King?**

**Saint Miguel Agustín Pro**, pray for us!




