

**From the Pastor  
2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of  
Advent - C  
December 5, 2021**

**THE HOLY HOUSE.** On October 7, 2019, the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, Pope Francis decreed that the optional memorial of Our Lady of Loreto be restored to the Church's Calendar for

December 10. On that day in 1294, the Holy Family's 30' x 13' Nazareth home, after brief stops in modern day Croatia and Recanti, Italy, reached its current 'home' in Loreto, Italy. While tradition says it was carried there by Angels, please keep an open mind and read 'the rest of the story' after praying the 'new' Collect for this 'new' Marian Feast Day.

**Collect - Our Lady of Loreto - optional memorial**

O God, who, fulfilling the promise made to our Fathers, chose the Blessed Virgin Mary to become the Mother of the Savior, grant that we may follow her example, for her humility was pleasing to you and her obedience profitable to us.

Through our Lord Jesus ... ever and ever. Amen.

**IS IT BELIEVABLE?** While matters of faith are always beyond 'proof,' they are reality-based. We know the Romans encased many sites to make them unvisitable, which unintentionally preserved them! In the 300's, when Constantine ended Christian persecution, holy sites were uncovered and reconstructed, and basilicas were built around them for protection.

Although Moslem forces destroyed 'The Holy House' basilica not once, but twice, the house itself was unscathed. In 1291, Christians were driven out of the Holy Land and the house 'disappeared' - only to reappear in Croatia and then in Italy; while Crusaders did the 'labor,' it was financed by the noble Byzantine Angeli family, who had it reassembled. [Thus, 'Angels' did make it happen!] Even modern-day archeological studies suggest the stones are from 1<sup>st</sup> Century Nazareth. The above photo shows the Sanctuary built inside the small house which sits securely in a huge basilica. Among its famous visitors are Galileo, Mozart, Descartes, Cervantes, and Saints Therese of Lisieux, Charles Borromeo, Francis de Sales, Louis de Montfort, John XXIII and John Paul II.

**"THE HOLY HOUSE'S REAL SIGNIFICANCE.** Whether or not is it the actual house in which the Holy Family lived, there once was such a place - which deserves our consideration. First, it would be the site where the Immaculate Conception took place when Saints Joachim and Anne conceived the child, whom they named Mary. Second, it would be the sacred site where Mary accepted God's offer, via the Angel Gabriel to be the Mother of His Son. In all probability, it was the home where the Holy Family lived and where Saint Joseph died. Simply being in a place that recalls these wondrous events makes it 'holy.'

While the house is now adorned with an Altar over which we find the Latin words: "Hic Verbum Caro Factum Est" - "Here the Word was made flesh" - it still has its humble stone and mortar walls. While it is all encased in marble, there is still a simple 1920 replica of an ancient statue, made from the cedars of Lebanon, which turned black due to the use of candles and incense over the centuries, and was destroyed in a fire. This 'Black Madonna,' as it is called, depicts Our Lady holding the Christ Child in regal garb. All these things challenge us who so often are quick to dismiss all that seems too ordinary, or too extraordinary, or simply too good to be true.

**THE HOLY HOUSE'S RECENT SIGNIFICANCE.**

As the supposed site of the Annunciation and the Incarnation, Pope [now Saint] John XXIII travelled there on October 4, 1962, one week before he convened the Second Vatican Council. He did so to entrust the Bishops of the Council to Mary, who, as the Acts of the Apostles records, was with the Apostles, our first Bishops, in the Upper Room, as they awaited the coming of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. Fifty years to the day, Pope Benedict made a pilgrimage there to start the 'Year of Faith.'

Via the web, make a virtual visit to the Basilica of the Holy House of Loreto; find and pray the Litany of Loreto, or Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary, often recited at the end of the Rosary. Or if you're afraid of flying, check out why Our Lady of Loreto is also the Patron Saint of Aviation and those praying for a safe flight. Our Lady of Loreto, pray for us.

## EXAMINATIONS OF CONSCIENCE (part two)

Before coming to Confession, examine your conscience with an 'Examen.' While waiting to confess, keep a safe distance from others. Begin with your state in life [*i.e., married, single, parent, etc.*] and estimated time since your last Confession; then list all grave, serious, major [mortal] sins by number and kind; a general admission of sinfulness suffices for less serious [venial] sins: i.e., impatience, intolerance, stinginess, lack of charity, forgiveness, etc. After the Priest offers a penance, listen to the Prayer of Absolution; pray the Act of Contrition **AFTER** you leave to lessen social interaction.

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart.  
In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good,  
I have sinned against you  
whom I should love above all things.  
I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance,  
to sin no more, and to avoid  
whatever leads me to sin.  
Our Savior Jesus Christ, suffered and died for us.  
In his name, my God, have mercy. Amen.

All penitents are asked to enter via the main doors of the Church; they will be given a number and directed to the Church where Eucharistic Adoration will take place. They are invited to spend time before the Blessed Sacrament both before and after having their confession heard. Priests will hear confession in the classrooms of the Parish Hall.
