**OUR RESPONSE TO THE GREAT GIFT OF EUCHARIST.**

On this Gaudete or Rejoicing Sunday, we offer part 18 of our series on the

USA Bishops' National Eucharistic Revival document The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church. In this article we will reflect on how we can best **RESPOND** to God's Great Gift of Eucharist. **A Quote from Saint [Mother] Teresa of Calcutta**

"When you look at the crucifix, you understand how much Jesus loved you then. When you look at the Sacred Host, you understand how much Jesus loves you now."

**RESPONDING TO GOD'S GIFTS.** We all know, from an early age, what I will call a **Gift-Receiver's Routine**. After we express our thanks for the gift, we unwrap, open or set it up; then we read the manual or instructions, insert the batteries and charge it up; then we use it and enjoy it. [And it never hurts to say 'thank you' again and again to the gift giver.] What we do - or should do - after receiving a Christmas or birthday, anniversary or graduation gift - or any gift - we must also do with the gifts given to us from God, especially the **Great Gift of the Most Holy Eucharist**.

Our Church's three-year **National Eucharistic Revival** intends to do all this and more - for those who actively take part in it. As we have mentioned in previous articles, it begins with coming to a deeper realization of **Our Lord's True Presence** in the Eucharist. As the quote above from **Saint Mother Teresa** reminds us: what Jesus once did on the **Cross** for us is truly made present again and again in the **Sacred Host** we adore and receive. That Jesus is willing to come to us and enter into us, with all the **graces or gifts** He won for us by His **Passion, Death and Resurrection**, is truly mind-boggling and amazing!

Going back to my initial analogy about gifts, we must ask ourselves: How often do I thank Jesus for the **Great Gift of Eucharist**? How often do I avail myself to receive this **Great Gift**? How well do I properly prepare myself to welcome Jesus as a **Guest** within me? Do I ready myself to receive Him by confessing my sins, doing penance, and performing acts of mercy or charity? Do I fast on special days of fasting and for one hour [medicine and water are always permitted!] before coming to receive **Holy Communion**?

Catholicism celebrates our unseen, invisible **God** and His **graces** with seen or visible signs and symbols. What does my outward appearance: my dress, my punctuality, and my active participation say about how important and central coming to receive Jesus is to me? Do I **make time for holy Mass** when I am away on vacation or for business, when I schedule sporting, hobby, workout, and other events?

Technically, the adage, "**Grace builds on nature.**" is incorrect; for **God** acts first, gifting us with so many 'graces' before we do anything! However, we must **cooperate** with God's gifts of grace if we hope to benefit from them; **God** forces nothing on us. We must be continuously open to learning more about, experiencing, and sharing **God's** gifts of grace with others. Do I avail myself to all that the **Church** offers, through her parishes or dioceses, publications or books, for ongoing faith formation? Do I subscribe to any **Catholic** periodicals, newspapers, websites, cable or radio stations? Do I even take advantage of what our Parish **PAYS FOR** through **FORMED**: the online **Catholic** website that offers videos, talks and other resources - for which all you must do is register and enjoy? [It is our gift to ourselves!]

**FULL, ACTIVE, CONSCIOUS PARTICIPATION.** As our Bishops remind us, "**The Second Vatican Council** taught that, in order to give thanks properly in the celebration of the Mass, we should 'take a full, conscious, and active part in the liturgical celebration.'" How can you get more involved in the sacred liturgy? What will you do to better understand and celebrate these most sacred rites?



Before coming to *Confession*, use an 'Examen' [below] to examine your conscience. Begin with your state in life [i.e., *married, single, parent, etc.*] and approximate time since your last *Confession*; list all grave, serious, major [mortal] sins by number and kind; a general admission of sinfulness suffices for less serious [venial] sins: i.e., impatience, intolerance, stinginess, lack of charity, forgiveness, etc. After the Priest offers a penance, listen to the *Prayer of Absolution*; pray the *Act of Contrition* **AFTER** you leave.

### AN EXAMINATION BASED ON OUR BLESSED MOTHER'S VISITATION AND THE MAGNIFICAT

*"Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb."*

Have I greeted others with a blessing - or with a curse?  
Have I borne bitter fruit in my thoughts, my words, or my deeds?

*"And how does this happen to me that the mother of my Lord should come to me?"*

Have I denied my own worth - or the worth of others?  
Do I deny God's presence in me - or in others?  
Have I missed God's presence because I am too busy, too hurried, or too anxious?

*"For at the moment the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the infant in my womb leaped for joy."*

Are my ears open to the sound of God's voice in unexpected people, places or encounters?

Am I so serious I cannot leap for joy or rejoice in God's presence within me? Within others?

*"Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled."*

Have I lost hope and faith in myself or others?  
In the Church or world, my Parish or community?  
Do I prevent God's Word from being fulfilled by my apathy or passive-aggressiveness, despair, complacency or lack of support?

*"My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my savior."*

Does my whole being, my every word and every deed, proclaim God's goodness and love? Do I sing and dance, play and rejoice with others as often as I can?

*"For he has looked upon his handmaid's lowliness; behold, from now on all ages will call me blessed."*

Have I acknowledged the quality of all people, regardless of their educational background, lifestyle, spirituality, political party, economic situation, physical or emotional condition, race or nationality?

Do I do all I am called to do so everyone, in every age and place, will call me blessed?

*"The Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name."*

Have I taken credit for what I have not done? Have I denied my own participation in the evil that takes place in my community, my Church, my family, my Country, or any associations?

*"His mercy is from age to age to those who fear him."*

Have I so lost my sense of mercy and compassion that nothing ever angers or sickens me? Have I so lost a healthy sense of fear, awe, and reverence that nothing ever moves me at my deepest core?

*"He has shown might with his arm, dispersed the arrogant of mind and heart."*

Have I been arrogant, haughty or unafraid of God - or used my own power, status, education, or religion to put others down, even in the silence of my heart?

*"He has thrown down the rulers from their thrones but has lifted up the lowly."*

Do I participate in and influence the political life of my city, state, and nation? Am I afraid to be prophetic or revolutionary because it may cost me my comfort?

*"The hungry he has filled with good things; the rich he has sent away empty."*

Am I gluttonous for praise, solitude or piety; do I only pray for those who are like me? Have I sent away empty, without acknowledgment, thanks or gratitude - anyone who has been good to me?

*"He has helped Israel his servant, remembering his mercy, according to his promise to our fathers, to Abraham and to his descendants for ever."*

Have I refused to give help and mercy to anyone, or broken my promises to anyone?  
Will I leave this world a more merciful, just, and loving place for my descendants?
