Paul exhorts the community to rejoice in God's peace, which is beyond the ability of our minds to grasp, and accomplishes more than we can imagine.

### The Gospel: Luke 3: 10-18

The ordinary people, not the religious leaders, are willing to repent, as they wonder whether or not John is the promised Messiah. He clarifies the issue and preaches the Good News as he inaugurates the time of salvation.

**BE RECONCILED TO GOD!**

In his second Letter to the Corinthians [5:20], which is the Second Reading on Ash Wednesday, Saint Paul implores us to “be reconciled to God” - which we do most

profoundly in the **Sacrament of Penance or Reconciliation**, aka ‘Confession.’ In response to the oft-asked question, “Why must I confess my sins to a Priest?” I often use an analogy. No doubt the **Lamb of God** died to take away the sins of the world, so forgiveness has been ‘won’ for us. But just as we must ‘cash in’ a winning lottery ticket to enjoy its prize, we must redeem, for ourselves, personally, what Jesus ‘won’ for us - and in both cases, there is a ‘cost’ in doing so.

When we ‘redeem’ a lottery ticket, we lose some privacy; family and friends [some we never knew we had!] will likely contact us, hoping to share in our blessings; but the prize is worth the cost. Likewise, nothing should keep an **individual** from redeeming for himself/herself all that Jesus won for us **collectively** by His Death. A little dose of humility is good, as is ‘having to come clean.’ Besides, your **Priest-Confessor** is also a sinner who must confess his sins. And to be honest: hearing the sins of others makes us more acutely [and painfully!] aware of our own sins.

**The Rite of Penance: The Prayer of Absolution**

God, the Father of mercies, through the Death and Resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I **absolve you** from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

**“GOD, THE FATHER OF MERCIES.”** After all is said and done by the *Penitent*, the *Priest* begins by calling *God* as the **‘Father of Mercies.’** Never forget that our *God* “knows how we are formed, [and] remembers that we are dust” [Psalm 103:14] - so *God* **GIFTS** us with compassion, forgiveness and mercy, undeserving though we are. And as *Saint Paul* reminds us: ***“God proves his love for us***

“in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us.” [Romans 5:8] - which leads to the next part:

**“THROUGH THE DEATH & RESURRECTION OF HIS SON HAS RECONCILED THE WORLD TO HIMSELF.”**

What the Church **solemnly** celebrates and presents each Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter, she offers each day with less pomp and majesty so that we can partake in these mysteries all year round. Since Jesus has already paid the price for our redemption, why not ‘cash in’ on all that has been gained for us? Be not like the unrepentant thief who bitterly clung onto his misdeeds and died in resentful anguish. Follow the example of the **Good Thief** who, by confessing his sins to the **Crucified Christ** was rewarded with **Paradise** - which, again, leads to the next part:

**“SENT THE HOLY SPIRIT AMONG US FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS.”**

On Easter night, the Risen Lord breathed the Holy Spirit into His Apostles and commissioned them to do as He did: to “**forgive or retain sins.**” [Cf. John 20:19-23] Since the decision to **forgive** or **retain** is not arbitrary or whimsical, those who receive the Holy Spirit in **Ordination** need basic knowledge of the sins being confessed. Thus, Jesus provided a safe haven for us to unload our sins, to ‘get it off our chest,’ and to be assured that no matter what we did, if we are truly repentant, we are forgiven - which leads to the next part:

**“THROUGH THE MINISTRY OF THE CHURCH MAY GOD GIVE YOU PARDON AND PEACE.”**

While **God** is not bound to Sacraments and can forgive anyone who seeks His pardon and peace, He has chosen to ‘make it real’ - in sacramental sign - so we can literally experience and know for sure His forgiveness and mercy.

**“EGO TE ABSOLVO...”** The **bolded** words, “**And I absolve you ... Holy Spirit,**” are all that are essential for a **valid** Confession, but its long form helps us appreciate this most medicinal means of experiencing **God’s** pardon and peace, grace and mercy, forgiveness and love! As an old Alka Seltzer commercial once said, “Try it; you’ll like it!”
