**'MURDER IN THE**

**CATHEDRAL.'** In this joyful Christmas week we honor the martyr who inspired T.S. Elliot's classic, '**Murder in the Cathedral**' and whose tale has been retold in plays

and movies. Saints are normally honored on their date of death, or rather, entry into heaven; but when that date falls in a 'privileged time' like **Christmas** week we transfer it to another date. **Saint John Paul II** died on **April 2**, which often falls during **Holy Week** or **Easter Week**, so his **Feast Day** is the date of his election to the papacy: **October 22**. But the situations which led to **Saint Thomas Becket's** murder, in his Cathedral, in Canterbury, England on **December 29**, 1107, as he began **Solemn Vespers** or **Evening Prayer**, are so horrid that the Church kept that date as his **Feast Day**. More about his life and assassination - and the lessons they offer us - after praying the Collect for the holy Mass offered in his memory.

**Collect - Saint Thomas Becket, Bishop and Martyr**

O God, who gave the Martyr  
Saint Thomas Becket the courage to  
give up his life for the sake of justice,  
grant, through his intercession, that,  
renouncing our life for the sake of Christ  
in this world, we may find it in heaven.  
Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

**A FRIENDSHIP TURNED SOUR.** Here's what the Bible says about a friend who turns against you: **"Is it not a sorrow unto death when your other self becomes your enemy?** [Sirach 37:2] The future **Saint** knew this sorrow, as he and King Henry II were close companions from their youth. The monarch named him the Chancellor; for years, he turned a blind eye to his highness' heinous antics. But after **Becket** was ordained a Bishop, he had a change of heart and mind, and became critical of the king's financial and personal activities. As our understanding of things change, are we willing to 'face the fire' and 'pay the price' - even if it wounds or severs our relationship with family or friends? Pray to **Saint Thomas Becket** to have - and act on - the courage of our convictions!

**KEEP WATCH OVER YOUR WORDS!** As their friendship faded and tensions rose, each 'let off steam' by negatively talking about the other to their friends and confidants. Did the **Archbishop**

**Becket** make matters worse by publicly criticizing King Henry, instead of privately chastising him? Did the king's exasperated exclamation, which some sources say was, "**Will no one rid me of this meddlesome Priest?**" have an unexpected outcome? For four of the knights who heard it took it literally - rode to Canterbury's Cathedral - and hacked the **Archbishop Becket** to death.

Although they were disgraced and received no rewards, and the king did public penance for causing the murder, and prayed for forgiveness at **Becket's** tomb, the damage was irreversible.

To avoid causing any unintended catastrophes, we must also 'keep watch over our words,' lest others act on what we rashly say or write. It is far better to express these things to God in prayer than to poison others with our anger. Again, ask **Saint Thomas Becket** to help you express your emotions in ways that confront wrongdoings without causing more harm.

**GOD ... GRANT ME THE WISDOM.** One of the most difficult quandaries is knowing when to fight and when to flee, when to hold firm and when to concede. Some say **Saint Thomas Becket** was so militantly radical, he set the stage for his own execution; some say the same about Jesus, whose confrontations with the leaders of His day made His crucifixion inevitable. Knowing how, when, or even if one should stand up for an issue is often very complex - so pray for wisdom!

**Archbishop Becket's** issue was Henry's meddling in Church governance and other ecclesial matters; demanding that everything be done his way cost him his life; so, too, with Jesus. Some say Pope Francis' concessions to allow China to have more authority over local Church matters have gone way too far. Again, these thorny situations require, or rather, demand much prayer.

Mercifully, we have holy men and women like **Saint Thomas Becket** who can guide us when we are faced with difficult decisions. **Saint Thomas Becket, pray for us.**

**Merry Christmas & Happy New Year 2021! 2020 was a difficult year in many ways. Let's pray that 2021 will be better for everyone.**
