



Luke 24:6



Reflections on Today's Readings

by Rev. Leonard N. Peterson

Reading I: Acts 10: 34a, 37-43

Peter's sermon contains the heart of the Apostolic preaching message, with the added promise of forgiveness of sin for all believers.

Reading II: Colossians 3: 1-4

The promises of the Messianic age are fulfilled in Jesus Christ. At the end of time, Christ and all the believers in Him will appear in glory.

The Gospel: John 20: 1-9

In John's gospel, written the last of the four, the full meaning of Easter is the completion of Jesus' return to His Father. Only then will the disciples "remember" and understand the meaning of these events. Meanwhile, "the Beloved Disciple" immediately believes in the resurrection, as opposed to the doubt of Thomas.

From the Pastor
Easter Sunday of the
Resurrection of the Lord - B
April 4, 2021

CHRIST IS RISEN! Even during this dreadful pandemic we can - and must - rejoice in Christ's victory over sin and death! And even as we mourn the loss of our beloved dead; pray for those who still struggle with

sickness and disease, economic and financial challenges; and deal with the sadness that comes from our inability to be with family and loved ones, we must also offer our prayerful thanks to God. For as Easter reminds us: suffering and death have been vanquished. As an Easter People, we must personally look, and help others to look, beyond 'cross and grave' to the promised glory awaiting us. And so, on this Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord, we chose to reflect on one of the two sets of orations offered at Mass during Ordinary Time in thanks to God for His countless blessings.

Collect - For Giving Thanks to God - A

O God, who always listen mercifully to your servants in distress, we humbly beseech you, as we give thanks for your kindness, that, free from all evil, we may constantly serve you in gladness.
Through our Lord Jesus ... for ever and ever. Amen.

GOD HEARS US IN OUR DISTRESS. As two psalm-prayers from the Divine Office say, "You heard the cry of your Son and kept him safe in your tent on the day of evil" and "when his last night on earth came, your Son shed tears of blood, but dawn brought incomparable gladness." These orations remind us that "Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me." [Psalm 23:4a]. Indeed, God is with us, and we will be victorious in the end, as was Jesus, over sin and death. No matter how dark or difficult, sad or sorrowful, frightful or frustrating, convoluted or crazy it gets, God is in charge, and with God on our side - or rather, us on God's side - we will win!

But how do we make our needs known to God? Do we spend time in prayer, entrusting our petitions to our Heavenly Father? Do we use the Parish Prayer Book? (although in this time of pandemic, it is not being used) While we say, "when one door closes, God opens another," the friends of that paralytic had to open the roof

over Jesus to let him down before the Lord! Do we also seek every means to pour out our hearts to God?

Prayer over / Offerings - For Giving Thanks to God - A

O Lord, who gave us your Son to rescue us graciously from death and from every evil, accept, we pray, in mercy this sacrifice, which we offer you in thanksgiving for our deliverance from distress.
Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

TRUST THE ONE WHO GAVE HIS ALL FOR US. While we all love the empty tomb and the Risen Lord's joyful appearances, we can never lose sight of the Cross He bore to redeem us. Nor can we forget that Jesus saved us through His suffering and death, which - potentially - gives us the hope needed to endure our own crosses. We say 'potentially' because being grateful or hopeful in difficult times does not come naturally; God gifts us with this supernatural grace, which we must first discover and then develop.

To be thankful, even as we face life's tensions and tragedies, we must recall that all of life is a gift we did nothing to deserve. Every breath, every heartbeat, is an unmerited gift from God. All that we have accomplished, despite the odds against us, is also God's gift. It is a gift that we can read and comprehend this article - and the list goes on and on. And the more often we think in these ways, and the more often we express our thanks in as many ways as we can, the more easily it will be to give thanks and praise to God at all times.

Prayer after Communion - Giving Thanks to God - A

Almighty God, who through this Bread of Life are pleased to free your servants from the bond of sin and in your compassion to restore their strength, grant us to advance without hindrance towards the hope of glory.
Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

HEAVEN HELPS US TO BE THANKFUL. While the pandemic affected us in so many ways, one of the worst ways was how it kept so many from celebrating or receiving the Sacraments. It is so good to see so many coming back to our spiritual home! As restrictions are eased, may we all get more into, or back into, the habit of regularly accepting all the sacramental help God offers us!


